39. How likely are you going to change your mind on your voting intentions in the presidential election?





41. In the case of the parliamentary election, how likely is that you would vote for your current MP?







44. Who do you trust to better manage the challenges in education, especially the free SHS?







47. Regardless of your choice about your voting intentions, do you believe that the NPP can "Break the Eight" ?



48. Are you a delegate who is allowed to vote in the upcoming party primaries?


