



Executive Summary

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



- A national opinion poll by Global InfoAnalytics for the 2024 presidential election shows the ruling party's candidate, Dr Mahamudu Bawumia (DMB) trailing the main opposition candidate, John Dramani Mahama (JDM) in the race to lead the country in 2025. The poll shows JDM leads with 54.3%, DMB, 34.9%, Alan Kwadwo Kyeremanten (AKK), 7.5%, Nana Kwame Bediako, 2.3%, others, 1%.

 Using weighted polling data, JDM surges ahead with nearly 56%, DMB, 34% and AKK, 7%, Nana Kwame Bediako (NKB), 2%
- □ Using weighted polling data, JDM surges ahead with nearly 56%, DMB, 34% and AKK, 7%, Nana Kwame Bediako (NKB), 2% and others 1%. The poll shows that, among first-time voters, JDM leads DMB 52% to 33% and among non-first-time voters, JDM leads DMB with 55% to 35%.
- In a twist at the regional level, JDM now leads in the North East region with 58%, DMB, 26% and AKK, 11%. In the turnaround for DMB in the Ashanti region, DMB has now regained the lead with 54%, JDM, 31%, AKK, 12% and Nana Kwame Bediako, 2%. DMB also made a significant recovery in the Central Region, a critical and must win region for the NPP in the 2024 election. However, he still trails JDM 45% to 51%.
- The poll also shows a disturbing outlook for the ruling government as the opposition leader extends his lead in the three critical swing regions (Greater Accra, Central and Western regions). Though JDM lost grounds in the Central region, his dominance in the Greater Accra and Western regions now stands at 66% and DMB, 28%, AKK, 5% and NKB, 1%.
- ☐ The poll also shows DMB making significant gains in the Oti Region and now at 42%, JDM 49%, AKK, 4% and NKB, 2%.
- ☐ In the Volta Region, JDM leads with 74% while DMB attracts 12%. The poll from the region shows AKK making strong gains as he now attracts 10% of the votes and NKB, 2%.
- ☐ John Mahama leads in 55 out of the 82 constituencies polled while Dr Bawumia leads in 26 and the two are tied in one constituency.
- On whether religion will play any role on voters' choice of candidate, 84% said religion is unlikely to play any role while 14% said it will play a role. In the previous quarter, nearly 24% said it will play a role, down 10%.

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The poll shows that 74% of voters are unlikely to change their mind on who they intend to vote, while 12% are
likely to change their mind with further 14% saying they are neutral about it. While 12% of NPP voters say they
are likely to change their mind, only 9% of NDC voters said they are likely to change their mind. For floating
voters, it is 12%. 77% of NPP voters are unlikely to change their mind while 79% of NDC voters say they are
unlikely to change their mind and 72% for floating voters.
On the question of whether voters support JDM's decision to retain Prof. Jane Naana Opoku Agyemang as his
running mate, the poll shows 60% of voters backing the decision, 15% oppose the decision and 25% are neutral
The poll also shows that 79% of NDC voters support the decision to retain the professor, while 49% of NPP
voters also support the decision and 54% of floating voters also back the decision.
On the issue of which campaign promises will influence voters in the December election, 48% said 24 Hr
Economy, Digitalisation, 29%, Great Transformational Plan (GTP),6% while 17% said they will not be influenced
by any of the slogans.
When voters were asked the extent to which they agree or disagree that Dr Mahamudu Bawumia is partly to be
blamed for the economic crisis, 60% of voters agreed compared to 34% who disagreed and 6% did not have an
opinion.
On the question of who is more trusted and competent amongst the leading candidates, the poll also shows
that JDM is the most trusted and most competent with a score rate of 2.05 out of 3.0. DMB comes second with
a score of 1.89 and ΔKK 1.72

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- According to the poll, majority of voters rate their MP's performance as average with 35%. 22% rate performance of their MPs as very good/good, while 23% rate their performance as poor/very poor. Only 11% rated their MPs as excellent and 10% did not have an opinion.
- When voters were asked which parties candidates they voted for in the 2020 parliamentary elections, 47% said they voted the NPP candidate while 43% voted for NDC candidates. However, for the 2024 parliamentary elections, 48% now intend to vote for NDC candidates compared to 34% for NPP, suggesting that NDC is more than likely to form the majority in the next parliament. The results show NPP making some grounds in the parliamentary elections following the selection of fresh faces during their primaries in January 2024. In the January 2024 poll, the NDC led the generic parliamentary race 52% to 31%, 21% lead which has now been cut to 14%.
- However, on parliamentary constituency from the current poll, the NDC leads in 49 constituencies, NPP is 31 constituencies and there is a tie in 2 constituencies.
- On whether voters believe the NPP will break the eight (8), the poll shows that 55% of voters do not believe the NPP can break the eight, 27% believe it can break the eight while 18% did not have an opinion. Only Eastern and Ashanti regions with a majority of 47% and 46% believe the NPP will break the eight.
- The poll also shows that only 60% of voters who voted for Nana Akufo Addo in the 2020 elections intend to vote for Dr Bawumia while 19% intend to vote for JDM, 9% will vote for AKK and 2% for NKB. 92% of JDM voters in 2020 elections intend to vote for him again, 3% will vote for DMB, 2% for AKK and 1% NKB.









Party Affiliations-90 Days Moving Average




Party Affiliations of First-Time Voters



Party Affiliations of Non-First-Time Voters





To what extent do you agree that Dr Mahamudu Bawumia is to be partly blamed for the economic crisis?









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


