


Methodology and Approach:

□Sample size: 7,931 voters were interviewed and 7,398 answered all the questions, representing 93% completion rate.
□Confidence level: 99% and Margin of Error of 1.42%.
☐Demographic analysis of the results would have higher margin of error.
☐The Electoral Commission's 2020 voters register was used as sample frame.
☐ The presidential poll is based using "All Voters", "Likely Voters" and "Pledged/Committed Voters" models.
\square The poll is cross-sectional and was carried out in 111 constituencies in all the 16 regions.
□Computer Assisted Personal Interviews were conducted between 21st - 30th June 2024



Voting Intentions – All Voters (Unweighted)






Voting Intentions –Likely Voters (Weighted)











Regional Distribution of undecided voters

First-Time v Experienced Voters-April 2024






Presidential vs. 2020 Elections- Regions
