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Executive Summary

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: SPECIAL POLL REPORT

NSAWAM ADOAGYIRI



- ❑ A special poll conducted by Global InfoAnalytics in the Nsawam Adoagyiri constituency confirms the result of the earlier suggesting that Hon. Frank Annoh-Dompreh, the majority Chief Whip, may be on his way out of parliament as the NDC's candidate for the 2020 election lead in a hypothetical race by 71% to 24%.
- ❑ 64% of voters rank the performance of the MP as poor/very whilst 8% rank his performance as good. 18% ranks his performance as neutral whilst 10% have no opinion.
- ❑ On whether voters were likely going to change their mind on who they will vote, majority of voters who indicated they are unlikely to change their mind support the opposition candidate, 73% whilst 23% backs Hon. Annoh-Dompreh, suggesting his fate may have already been sealed.
- ❑ Analysis of the poll also shows that only 40% of NPP sympathisers have indicated they will vote for him whilst 40% were voting for the opposition candidate with 10% voting for someone else.



Methodology & Approach

Methodology and Approach:

Analysis of the report is based on “Likely Voters” Model. Voters who indicated they will not vote were excluded from the overall analysis for the primaries and general elections head-to-head.

Sample Size: 412

Confidence Interval: 95%

Margin of Error: MoE of $\pm 4.828\%$

Population of voters in the constituency: 72,926

Sampling Frame

- The 2020 Electoral Commissions voters’ register was used as a sampling frame for the purpose of allocating sample size to each electoral areas selected.

Sampling Method:

- 15 out of 29 electoral areas with highest voter population were sampled.
- The electoral areas selected account for 77% of total voters in the constituency
- Voters from each electoral areas were selected randomly for the interview

Fieldwork:

- Interviews were carried out between 1st July – 15th July 2022.

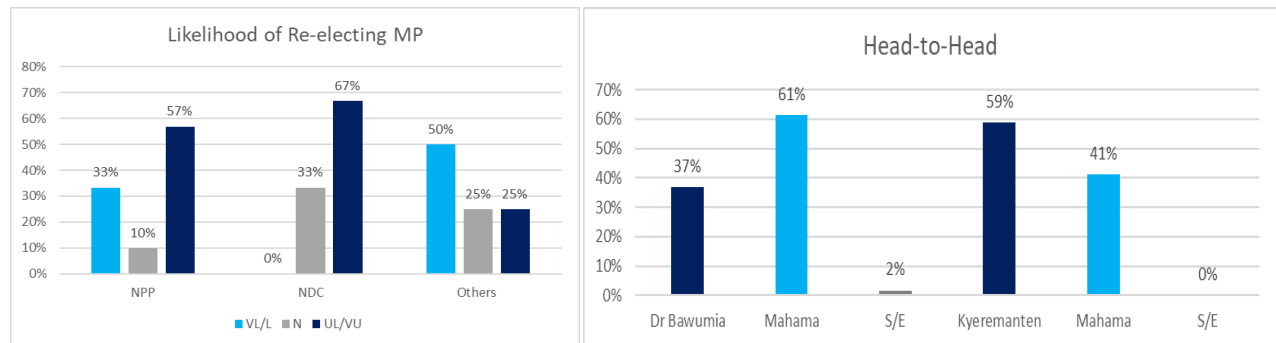

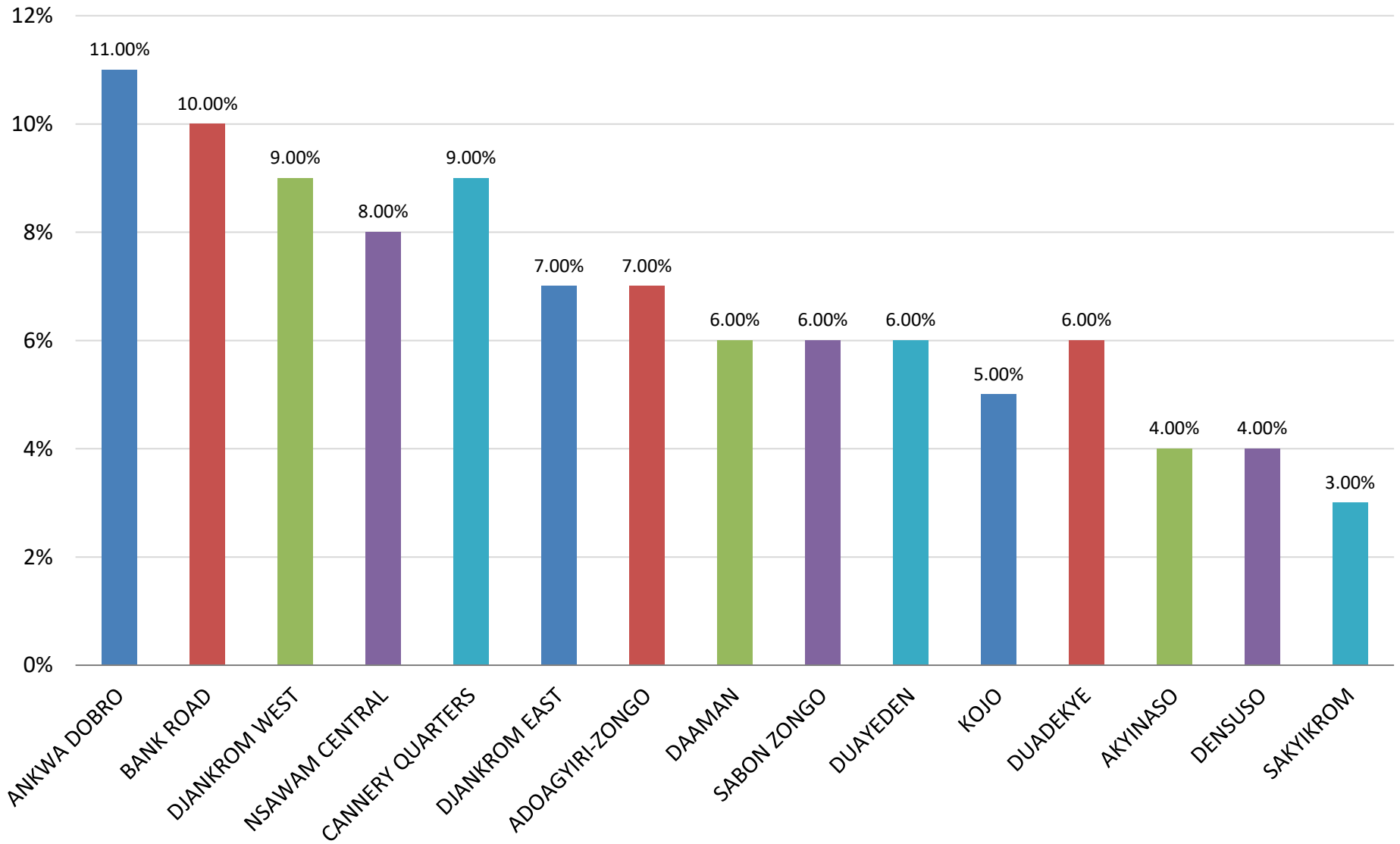
ANALYSIS AND COMMENTARY

- ❑ Right Direction: 31%. Wrong Direction 60% . No opinion 9%
- ❑ Presidential Approval: Approve-37%, Disapprove- 61%, No opinion-2%
- ❑ Party Affiliation: NPP,66%. NDC, 8%. FV, 0%, Other,26%.
- ❑ Very Likely/Likely 22%. Very unlikely/unlikely 62%. Neutral 16%

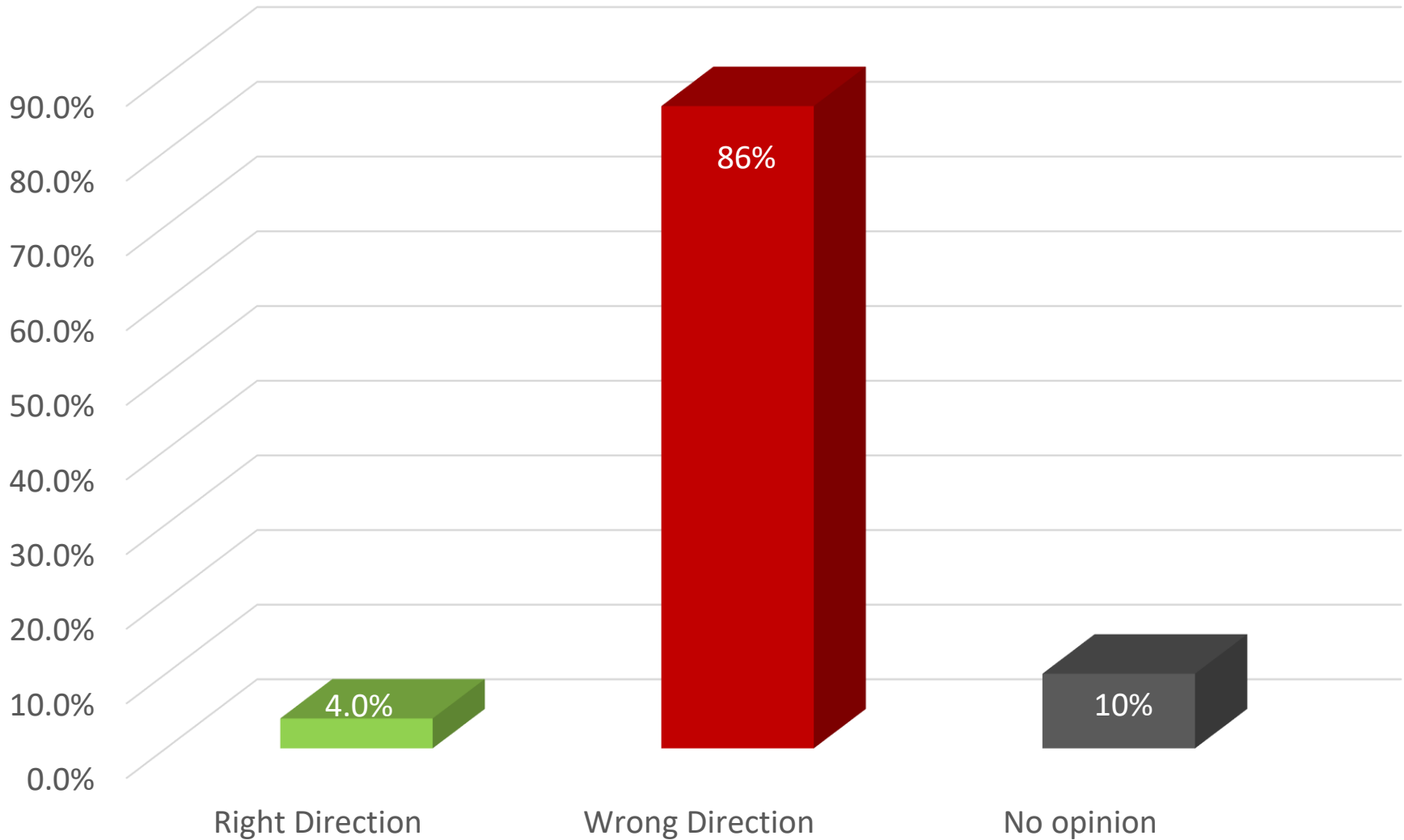


Conclusion: The incumbent MP and Majority Chief Whip is on the rope as both NPP and NDC voters' gang against him with 62% indicating they are unlikely to vote for him including 57% of NPP affiliate voters. His woes could deepen if Dr. Bawumia is the candidate as John Mahama lead him with 61% of the votes. If he survives the primaries, his re-election bid will be very dicey and could lose his seat.

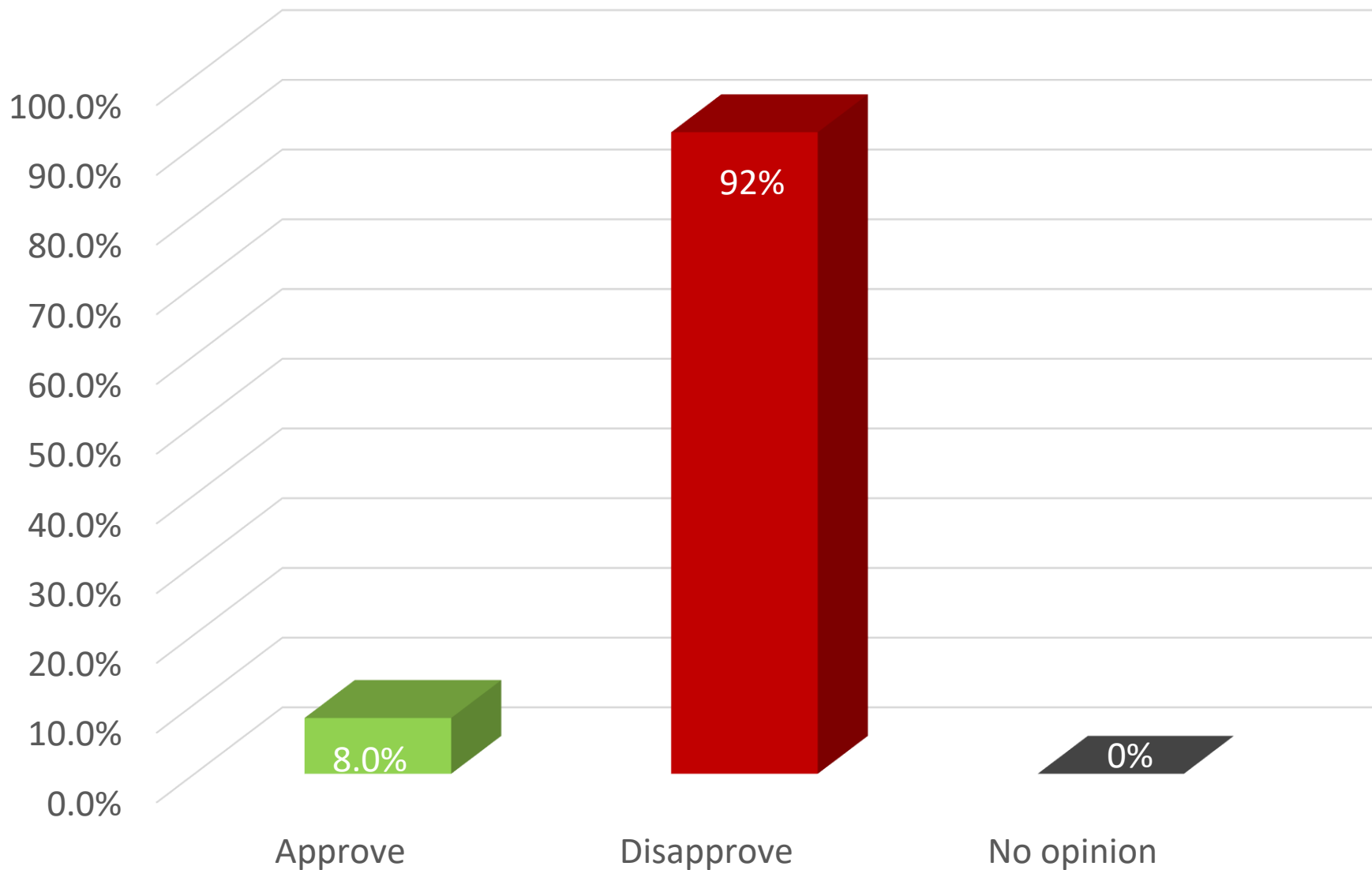
Sample Allocation to Electoral Areas



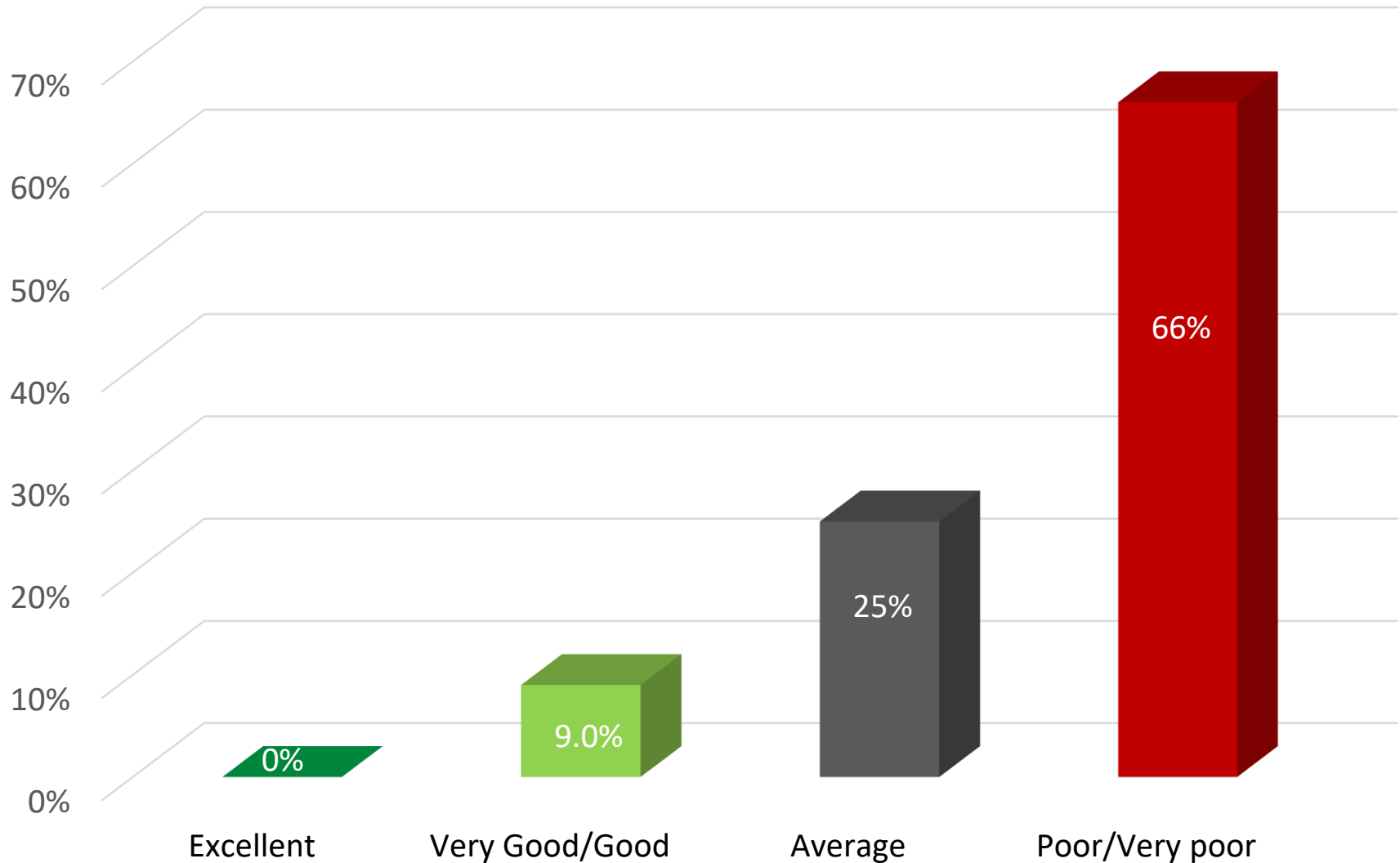
Would you say things in this country today are generally headed in the right direction or wrong direction?



Do you approve or disapprove of the way H.E. Nana Akuffo Addo is doing his job as president?

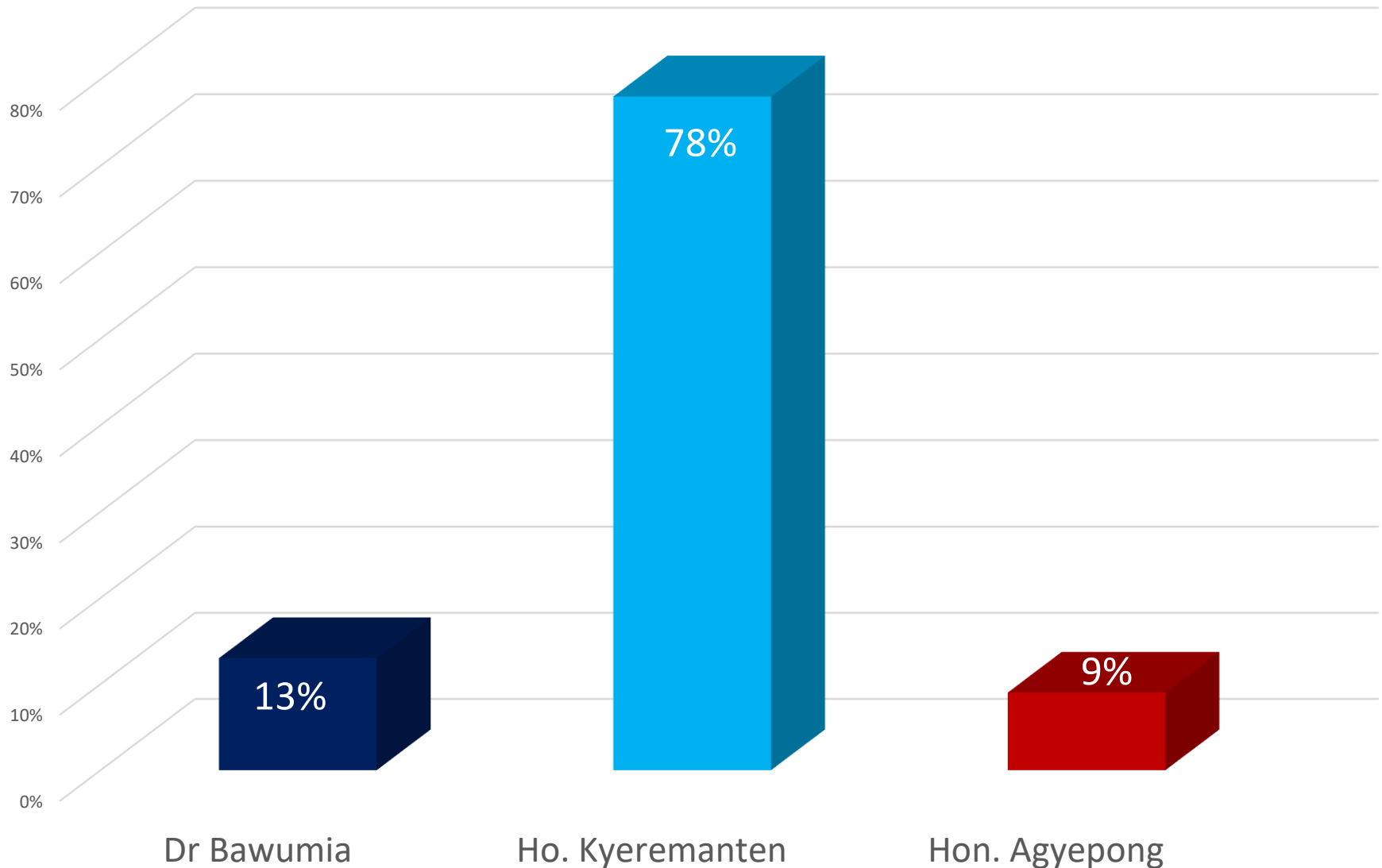


*How would you rank the government's performance since 2020 elections?



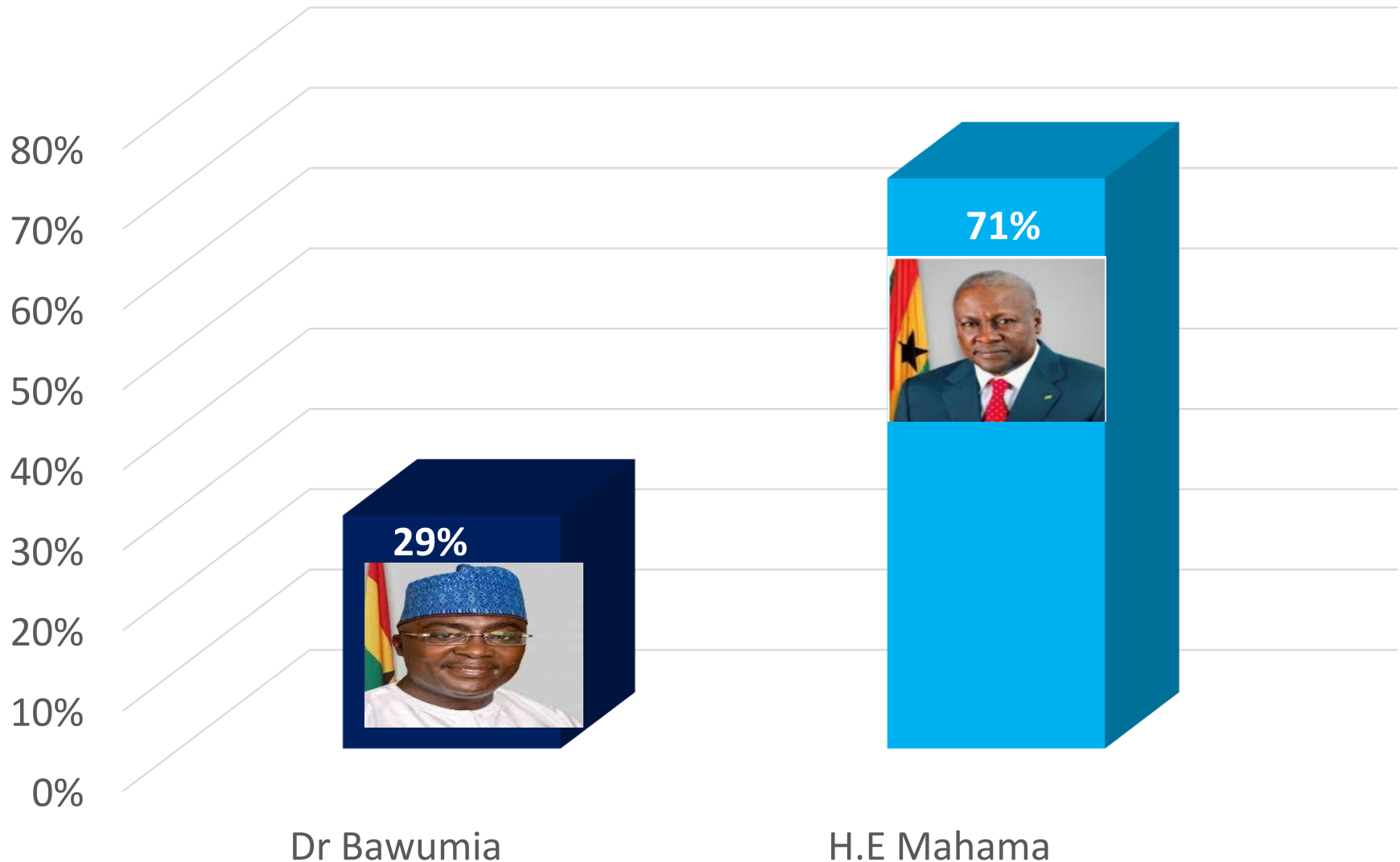
NPP Primaries

If you were a delegate at the next NPP presidential primaries, which of the following candidates would you vote for?

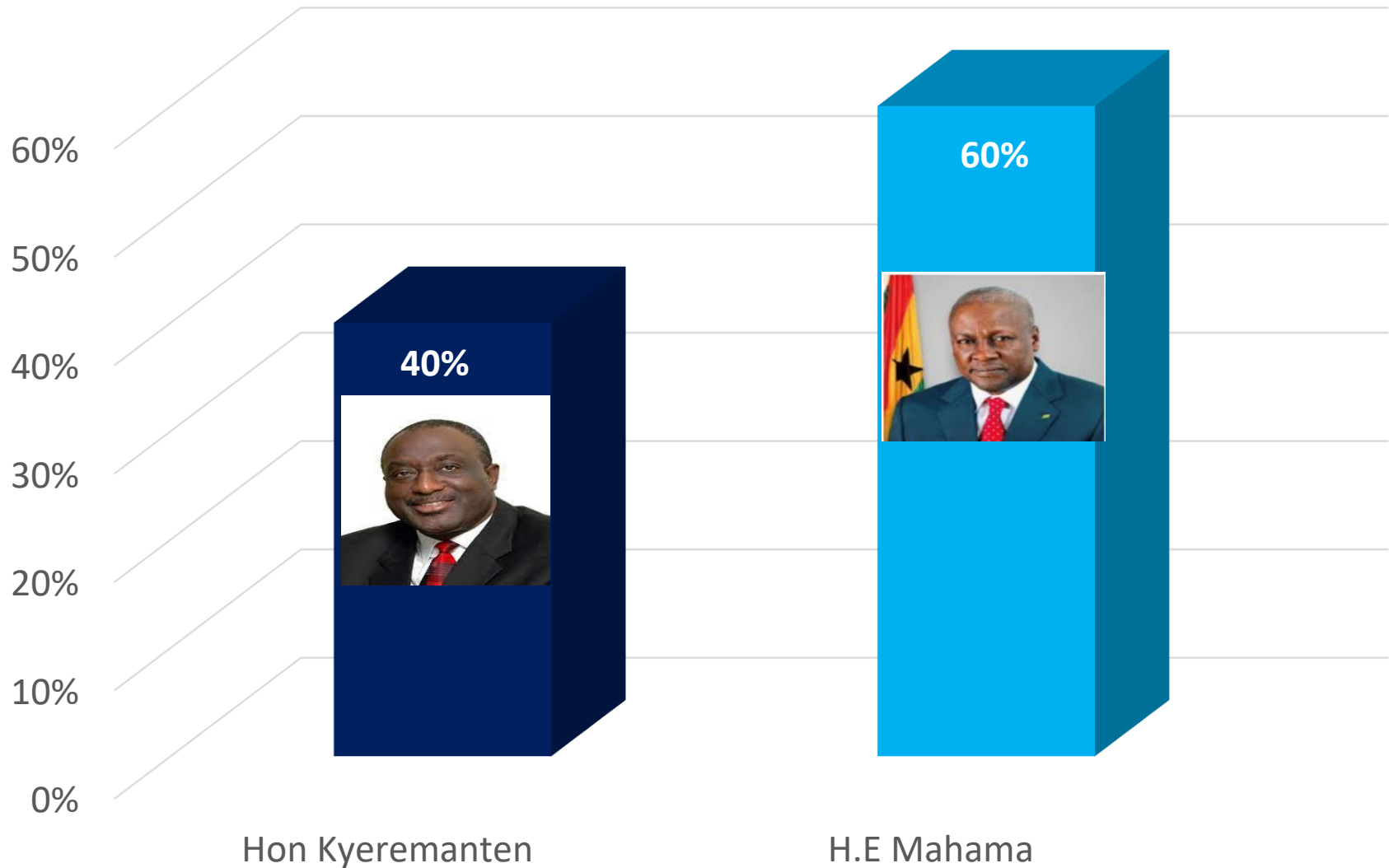

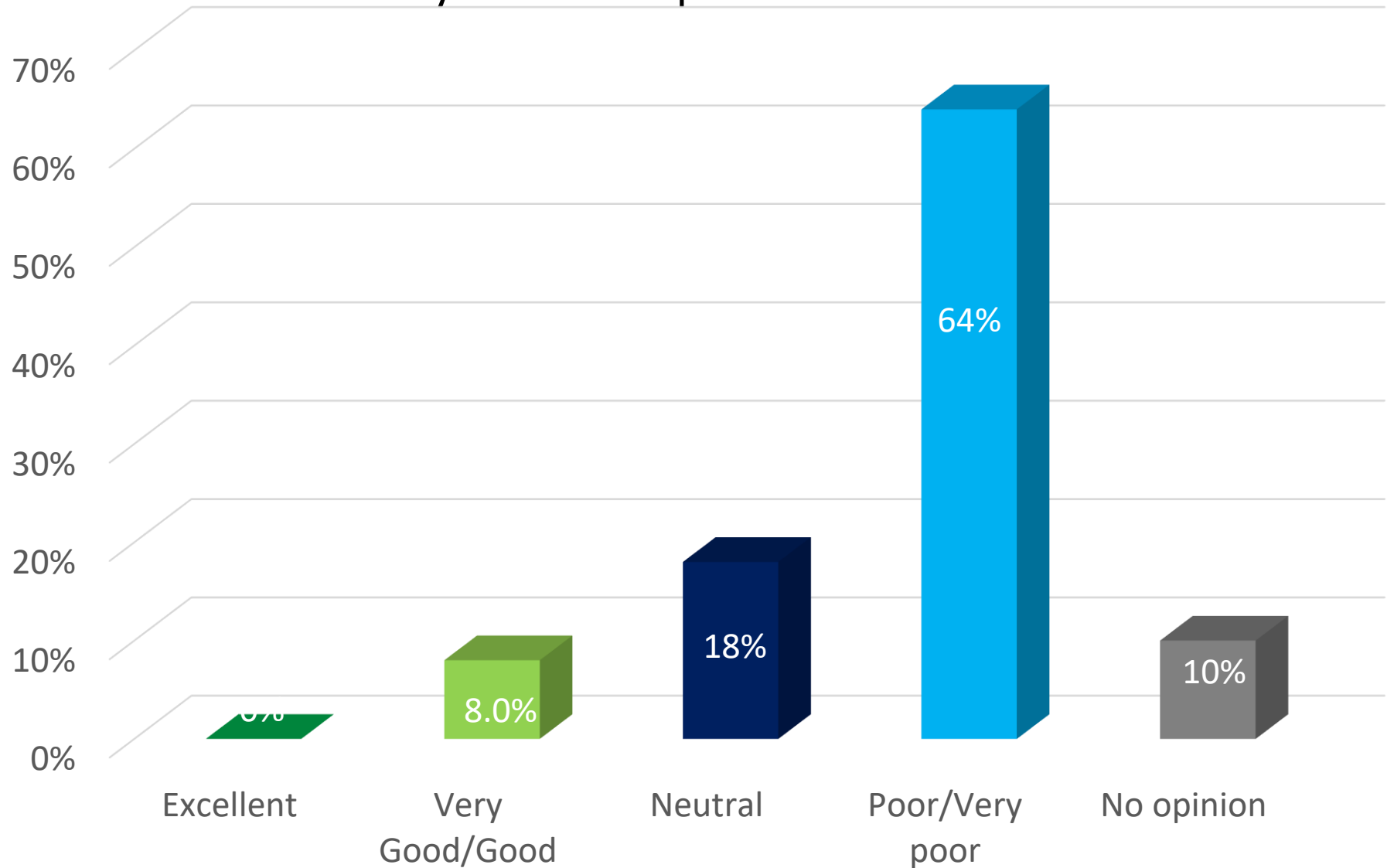

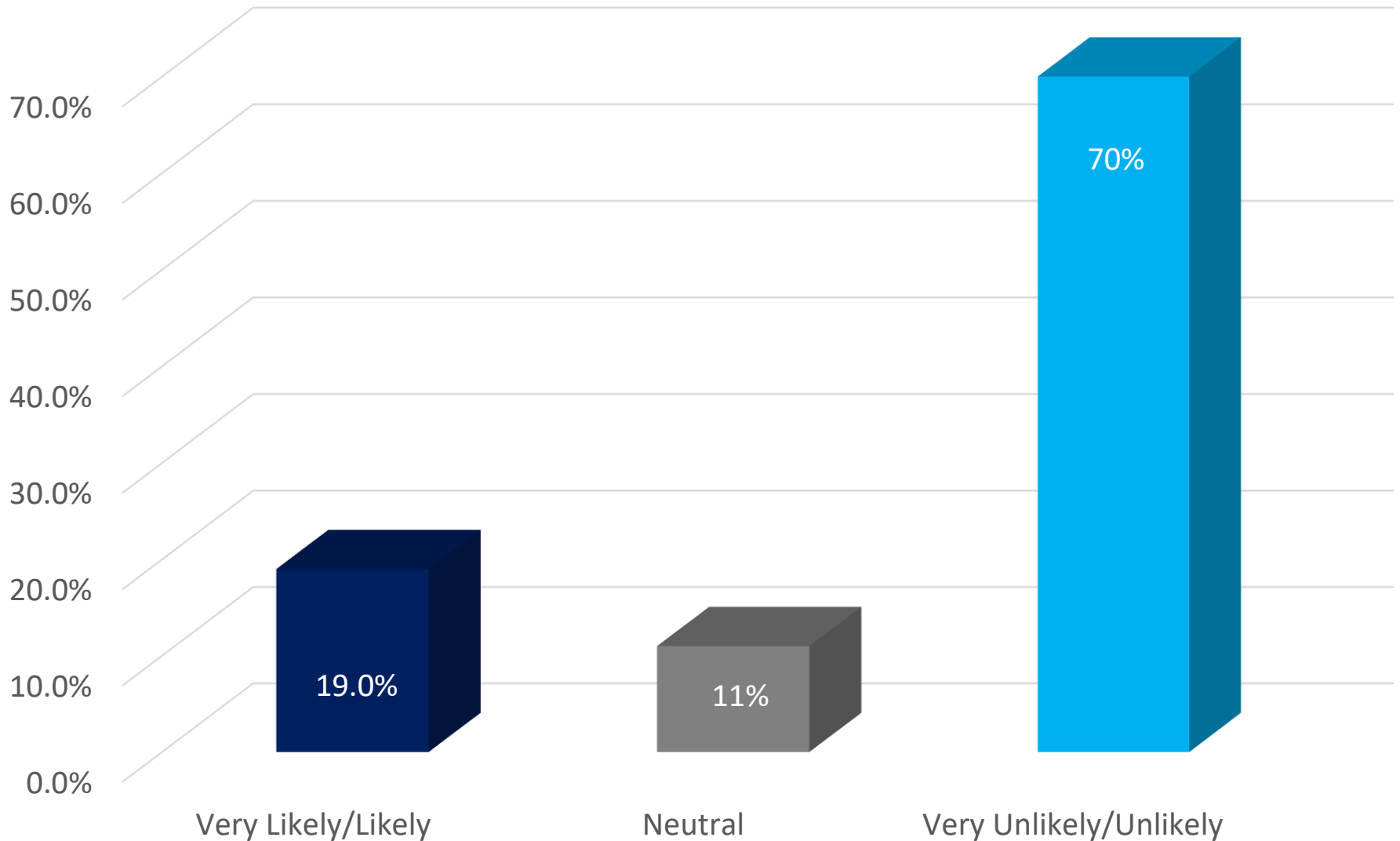

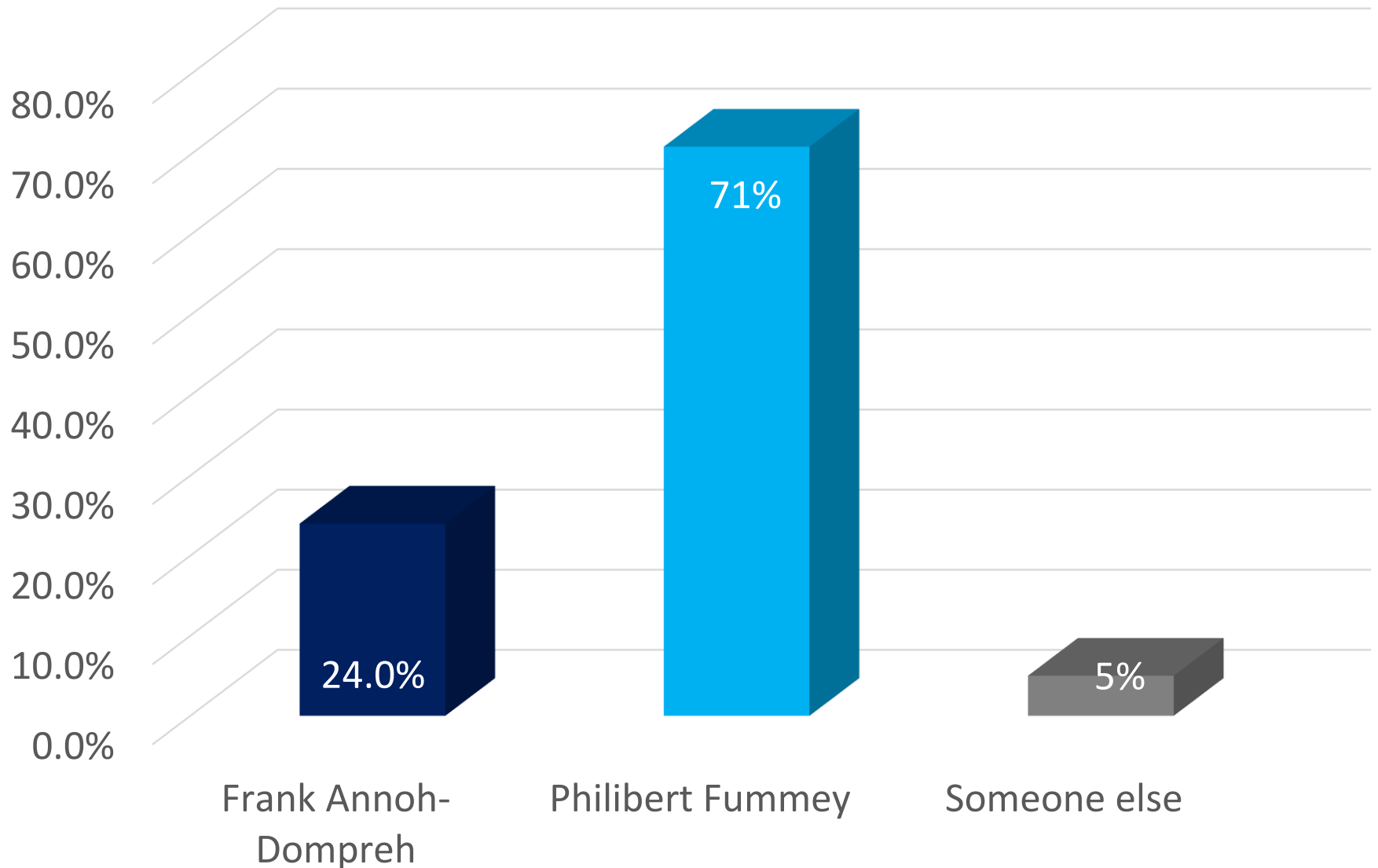
Your MP, Hon FRANK ANNOH-DOMPREG has been in office almost a year and half now since the 2020 elections, how would you rate his performance so far?



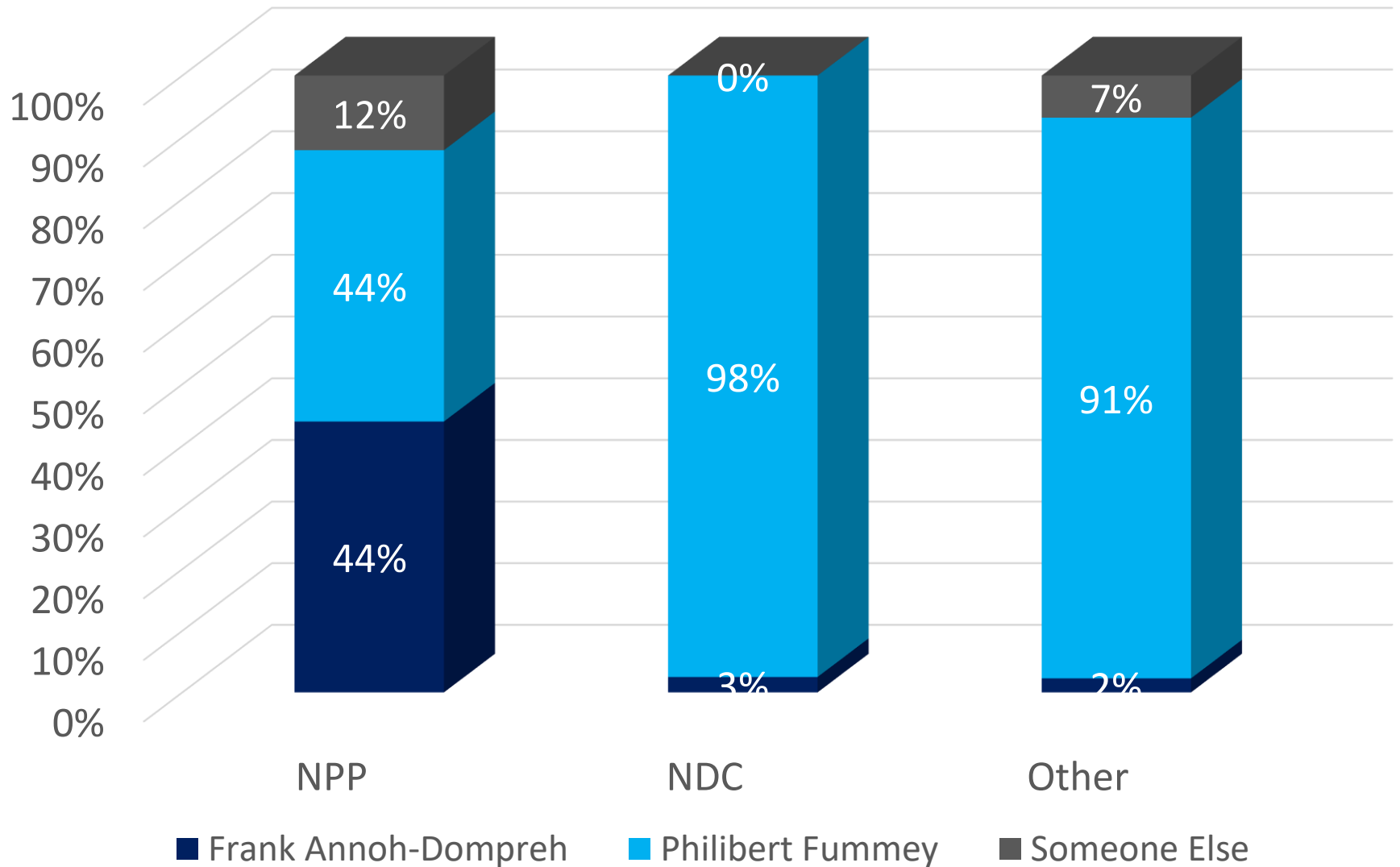
How likely would you vote for FRANK ANNOH-DOMPREH as your MP if he stands again in 2024 elections?



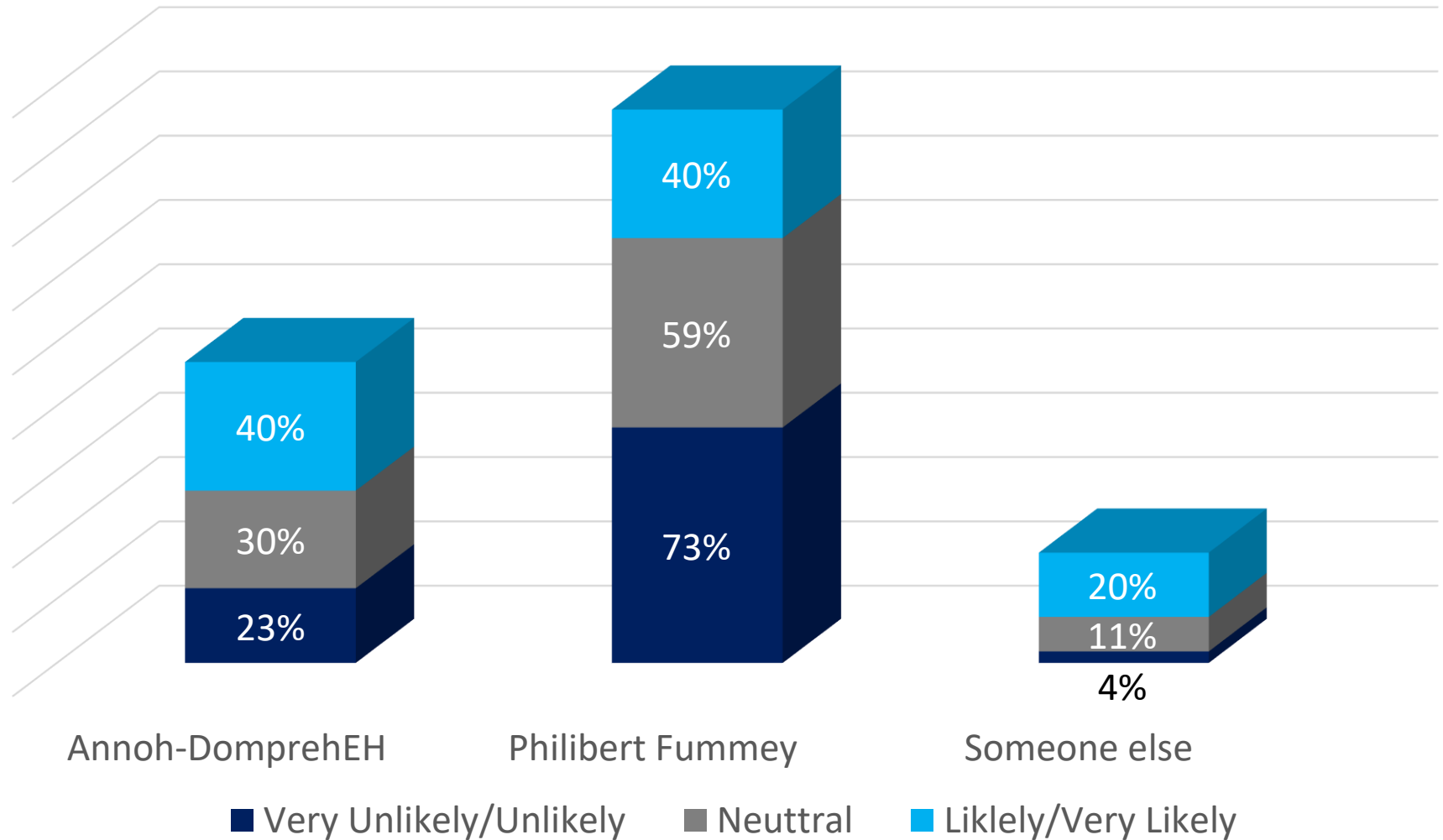

Are you likely to change your mind on who you intend to vote for if the economy improves? Parliamentary Head-to-Head

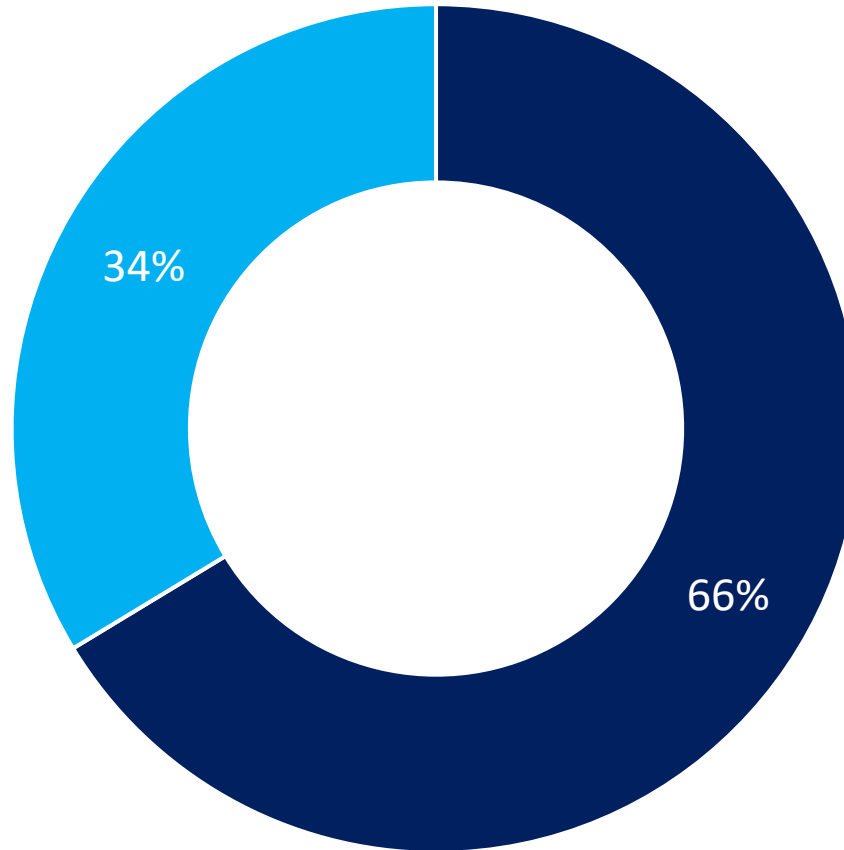

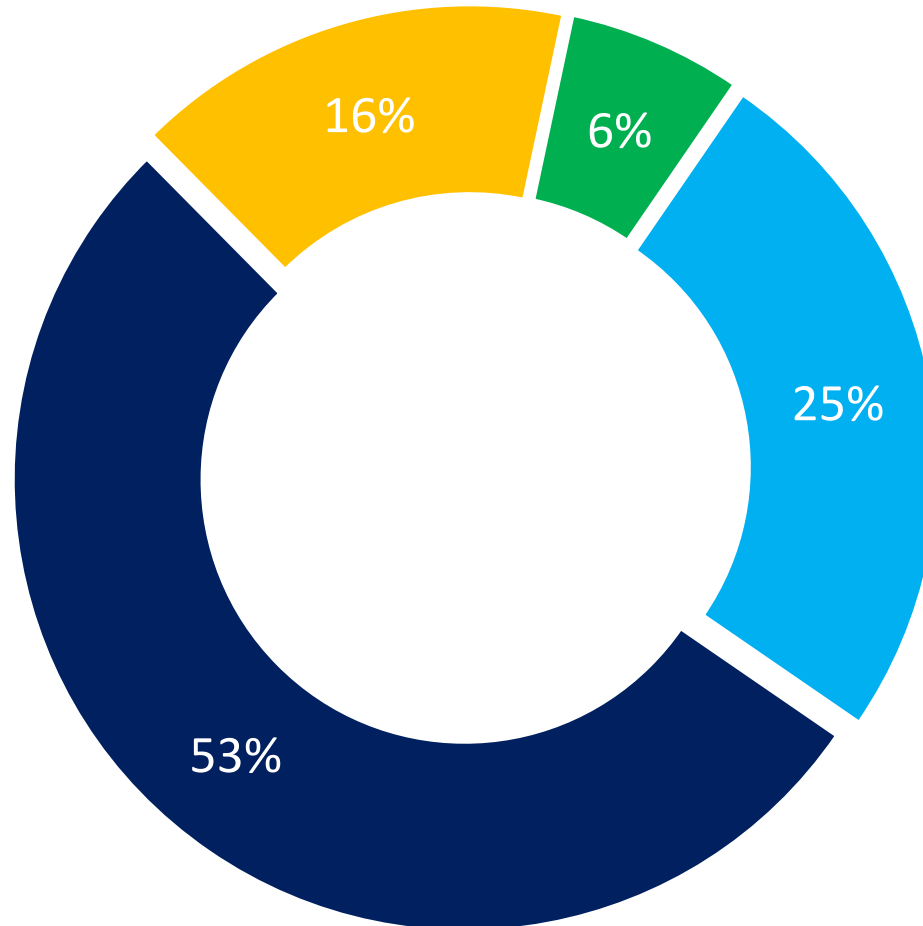

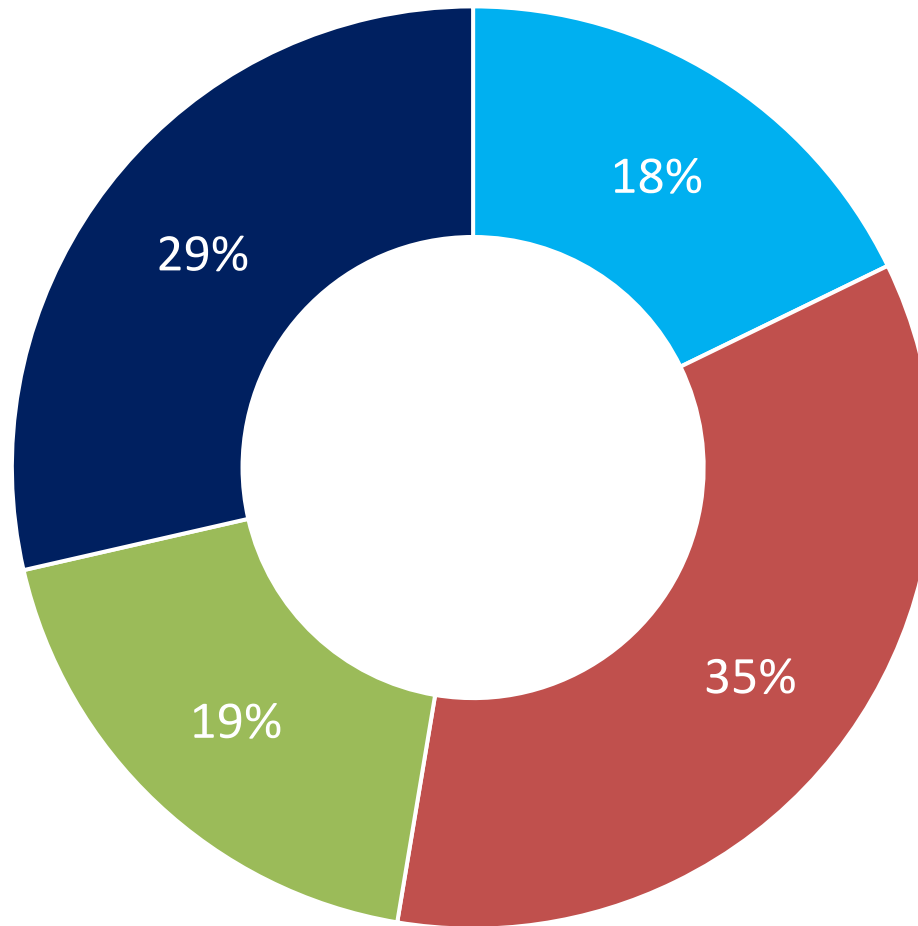

Age Group



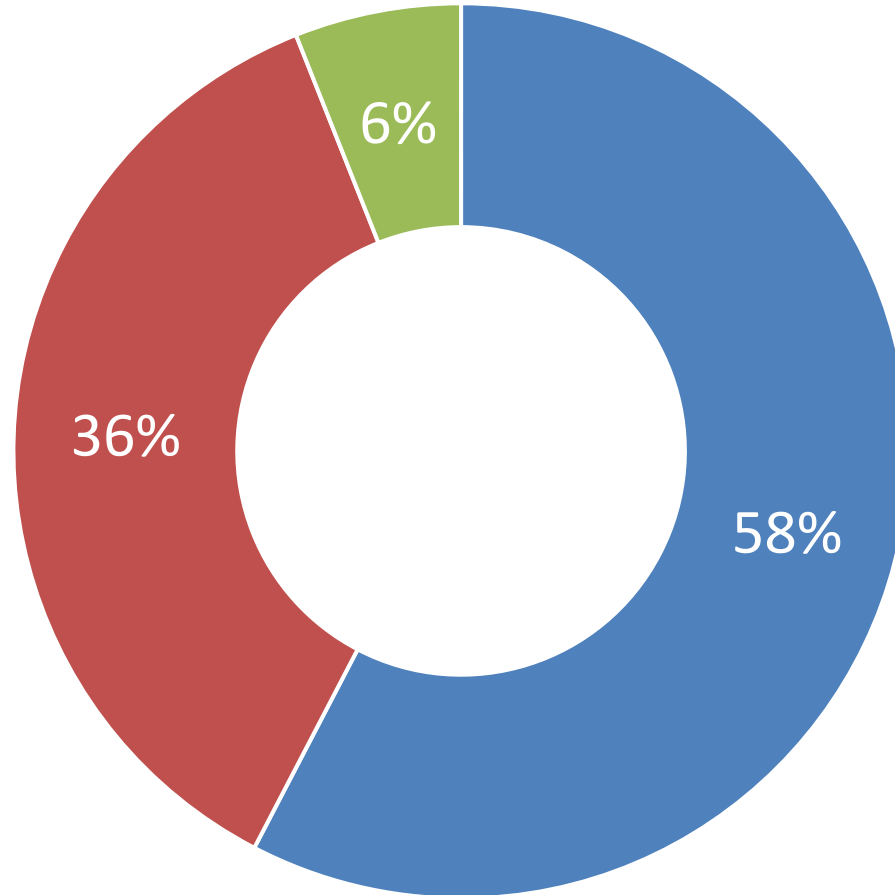

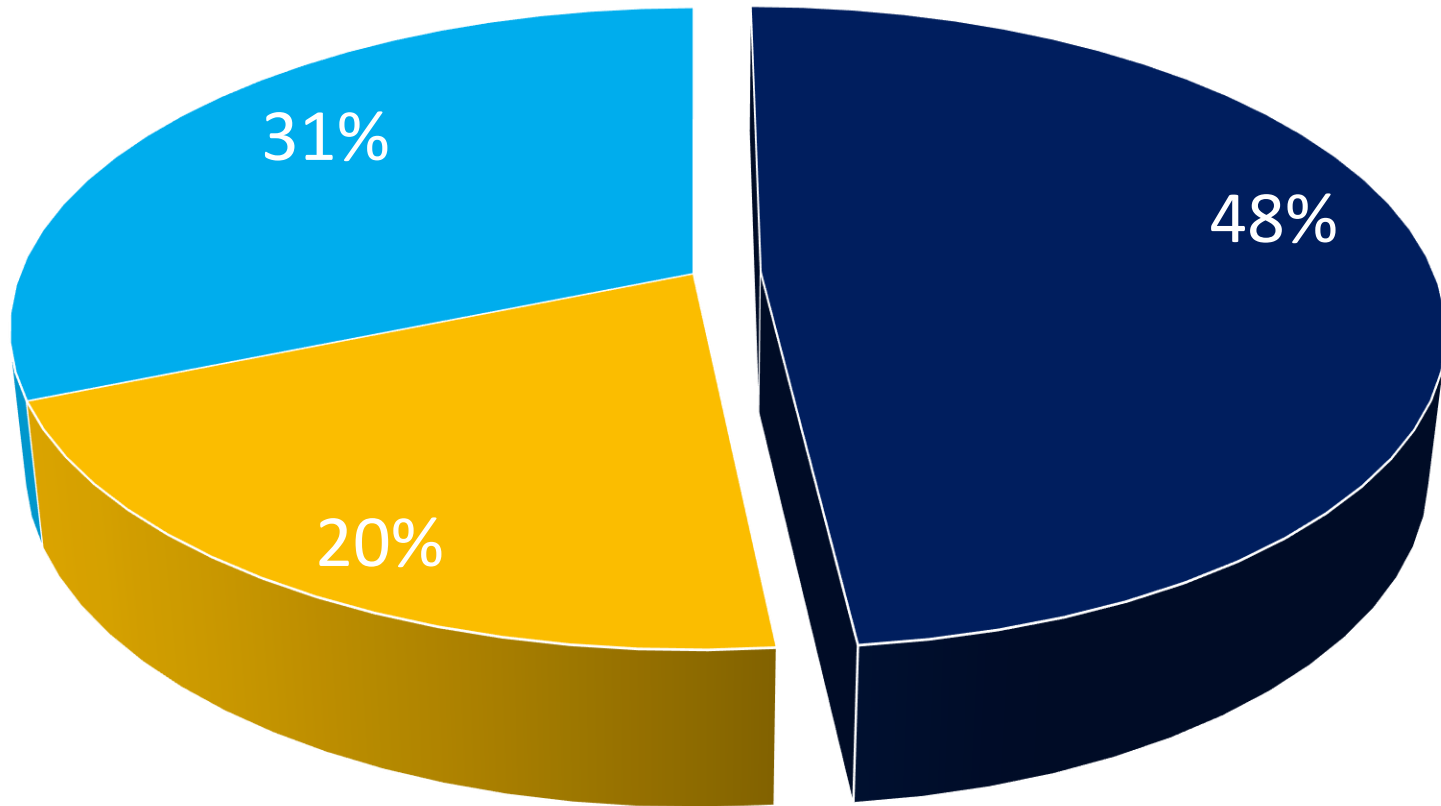
