# 2nd National Tracking Poll – Q 1 19<sup>th</sup> April 2022

# 2022



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#### Introduction

This is the second national tracking poll by Global InfoAnalytics in 2022 following the first baseline poll which was carried in January 2022.

The Quarter 2 poll was carried out between 7<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> April 2022 in all the sixteen (16) regions and sixty-eight (68) constituencies.

#### Methodology and Approach

#### Sample Size

• A total sample size of 5120 was chosen

#### Margin of Error

• The Margin of Error was estimated using population of size (N) of 4,685,495 and a sample size of 5,120, resulting in MoE of ±1.799% at 99% confidence interval.

#### Sampling Method

- 34 constituencies that were previously selected under convenient sample was repeated for purposes of establishing polling trend.
- Additional 34 constituencies were selected using random sampling. The previous constituencies polled in January were excluded prior to running the random simulation model to select the constituencies. Thus, giving the remaining 241 constituencies an equal chance of selection.

#### Sampling Frame

- The 2020 Electoral Commissions voters' register was used to allocate samples
- Allocation of interviews was based on the total registered voters in the constituencies relative to the 68 constituencies selected.
- For each constituency selected, the location for the interview was also selected randomly from three Electoral Areas of the constituency.
- Voters older than 16 years were interviewed as part of the poll

#### **Summary of Polling Report**

#### Direction of the country

67% of voters believe the country is heading in the wrong direction compared to those who believe it is heading in the right directly, 26%. 7% of voters indicated that they have no opinion. Compared to baseline poll, the proportion of voters who believe the country is heading the wrong direction increase from 58% to 67%, representing +9%.




Figure 1 Direction of the country

Analysis of the data shows that 47% of NPP affiliates in April are of the view that the country is heading in the wrong direction compared to 35% in January 2022, this representing an increase of 12% of the period. For NDC affiliates, 84% believe the country is heading in the wrong direction in April compared to 80% in January 2022, representing an increase of 4%. For Floating voters, the new poll saw an increase from 64% in January 2022 to 69% in April 2022.

Only NPP affiliates believe the country is heading in the right direction of a sizeable margin as 47% agreed to the question. However, this represent a drop of 10% from January 2022 where it stood at 57%.




Figure 2 Direction of the country by party affiliations

#### President's Job Approval

The president approval rating saw a drop of 7% in April 2022 compared to January 2022. In the current poll, only 27% of voters approve of the president's performance compared to 67% who disapprove him, resulting in net approval rating of -40%.




Figure 3 President's Job Approval

Compared the January 2022, the president's disapproval increased from 58% to 67%, moving in the same direction as voters who believe the country is heading in the wrong direction. Voters who don't have opinion declined from 8% in January to only 6% in April.




Figure 4 President's Job Approval by Party Affiliations

The poll also shows that only 50% of NPP affiliate voters believe the president is doing a good compared. 44% think he is performing poor and 6% don't have opinion. For NDC voters, 84% believe the president is doing a poor job compared to 12% who believe otherwise with 4% having no opinion. In the case of floating voters, only 16% believe the president is doing a good job, 72% believe he is doing a bad job as president whilst 12% have no opinion.

These results are significantly worse than the results from the baseline poll where 34% of NPP affiliates believed the president was doing a bad job, an increase of 10% from 34% to 44%. For the NDC, there was an increase of 2% from 82% to 84% whilst floating voters saw a jump of 10% from 62% to 72%.

#### Government performance

The overall performance of the government also saw a deterioration as only 25% of voters believe the government has performed very good/good. 49% of voters rank the government as poor/very poor in April poll. Only 5% rank the government excellent with 21% suggesting it is an average performance. Compared the January poll, the government performance deteriorated as the proportion of voters ranking the government performance as excellent drop from 7% to 5% very good/good from 32% to 25%, average from 24% to 21% and poor/very poor from 37% to 49%.




Figure 5 Performance of the government

#### Current state of corruption in Ghana

On the state of corruption in the country, only 14% of voters believed it is improving according to the latest poll. 54% believed it is getting worse whilst 9% said they have no opinion. Compared to January 2022 poll, the proportion of voters who believed is improving dropped by 9% whilst those who believed it is worsening increased by 11%. Those who believed it has stayed the same dropped from 29% to 23%.




Figure 6 State of Corruption

#### Fight against corruption in the country

On the question of what voters believed the government is doing enough to fight corruption, only 25% believe it whilst 66% said "No" whilst 9% have no opinion. This poll numbers represent a deterioration compared to January when 30% thought the government was doing enough, a drop of 5% and an increase of 7% for voters who think it is not doing enough.

#### Confidence in the country's Judiciary

On the question of whether voters have confidence in Ghana's judiciary, only 24% have very high/high confidence in the judiciary (9.5% Very High and 14.7% High). Twice as much as those with high confidence have low/very low confidence in the judiciary, 46%. 30% of have neither low or high confidence in the judiciary.




Figure 7 Confidence in the Judiciary

#### Confidence in the Supreme Court

In the case of Supreme Court in particular, 26% of voters have very high/high confidence in the court whilst 47% have low/very low confidence in it whilst 27% of voters are indifferent about the court.




Figure 8 Confidence in the Supreme Court

#### Standard of living

On the issue of standard of living in the country in the in the last 12 months, only 15% of voters indicated that their standard of living has improved in April 2022 compared to 50% who said it has worsened. 28% said it has not changed whilst 8% have no opinion.

In January 27% of voters said their living standard has improved, thus a significant drop of 15% to the latest poll. For those indicating it has worsened, the latest poll shows 12% increase, a switch from improved to worsened.




Figure 9 Standard of Living

# Optimism for improvement in the next 12 months

For those who indicated their standard of living has worsen, a follow up question on whether they were optimistic that the situation will improve in the next 12 months, only 30% were optimistic whilst 54% were pessimistic and 16% had no opinion.




Figure 10 Confidence for improvement in living standard

#### Likely voters in the 2024 general election

Approximately 65% of voters indicated they are very likely /likely to vote in the 2024 election whist 20% said are likely/very unlikely to vote. 15% are not sure if they would vote.




Figure 11 Likely voters in the general election

#### Top three issues for voters for choosing a president in the 2024 elections

Top issues voters will consider before voting for a candidate in 2024 are economy, 21%, jobs, 19%, education 17%, petroleum prices, 9%, healthcare 8% and roads 8%.




Figure 12 Top issues for voters

### Voters preference for NPP presidential race

For the NPP's flagbearer race, the poll found Alan Kwadwo Kyeremanten leading H.E Dr Mahamudu Bawumia with for the first time in Global InfoAnalytics national poll. The found Alan Kyeremanten is backed by 35.5% of voters to lead NPP whilst vice president Dr Bawumia attract 33.2%. In the distance third was Hon Kennedy Agyepong with 3% and Dr Afriyie Akoto forth with 2.9%.




Figure 13 NPP Flagbearer race

The April poll saw a dramatic shift in the race for the NPP which the vice president has had commanding lead in the January 2022 polls with 39.7% of support compared to Alan's 28%.1%. in the April poll, Alan staged a comeback with 7.8% increase over his January performance whist Dr Bawumia dropped 6.5%.




Figure 14 NPP Flagbearer Race- Reginal Results




Figure 15 NPP Flagbearer Race- Reginal Results

#### Voters preference for NDC presidential race

For the opposition NDC, the former president, HE John Dramani Mahama has unassailable lead over the former finance minister Dr Kwabena Dufour and the former mayor of Kumasi Metropolitan Assembly, Hon. Kojo Bonsu for the leadership of the party. John Mahama has 57% of voters support whilst the Kwabena Duffour has 12% and Kojo Bonsu, 4% whilst 8.9% of voters prefer someone else to lead the party.




Figure 16 NDC Flagbearer race

#### Head-to-head- Dr Bawumia v John Mahama

When voters were asked to indicate between Dr Bawumia, the vice president and John Mahama, who would they vote for of the two emerged as flagbearers of their respective parties, John Mahama leads with 53.8% whilst Dr Mahamudu Bawumia attracts 30% and 8% of voters would like to vote for someone else whist 9% said they will not vote.




Figure 17 Head-to-Head - Bawumia v Mahama

#### Religious factor on Dr Bawumia and John Mahama race

This contest will pitch a Christian against a Muslim candidates both of whom come from the northern part of the country and their faith is expected to play a role according to experts. The poll shows that 15% of voters said the religion of the two candidates is was factor in selecting their candidates. Approximately 73% said their faith was not a factor with another 12% certain it had neutral impact on their decisions.




Figure 18 Religious factor on Dr Bawumia and John Mahama race

#### Dr Bawumia v John Mahama- Key Demographic Analysis

John Mahama attracts 54% of the male votes and 51% of the female votes compared 30% and 31% respectively for Dr Bawumia.




Figure 19 Bawumia v Mahama - Gender

Whilst Dr Bawumia attracts 60% of NPP affiliates votes, John Mahama is attracting 86% of NDC votes. John Mahama attracts 24% of NPP votes compared to only 10% for Dr Bawumia from the NDC. More significantly, compared to January 2022 poll, Dr Bawumia's support from the NPP base has declines 16%.




Figure 20 Bawumia v Mahama - Party Affiliations

Amongst the large faith groups (Christianity and Islam), John Mahama has significant lead over Dr Bawumia in the Q1 poll as 49% of Christians backs him. Fort Muslims, 61% back John Mahama compared to 33% and 28% respectively for Dr Bawumia.




Figure 21 Bawumia v Mahama - Main Religions

For the Q1 poll, Mahama wins across all levels of education and significantly lead those without education and those with tertiary educations.




Figure 22 Bawumia v Mahama - Educational Level

#### Head-to-head- Alan Kyeremanten v John Mahama

However, in a scenario where Alan Kyeremanten is elected to lead the NPP against NDC's John Mahama in the 2024 election, John Mahama is supported by 50% of voters whilst Alan attracts 37% support. 5% of voters will vote for someone else whilst 8% said they will not vote.




Figure 23 Alan v Mahama - General Election

#### Ethnic factor in Alan Kyeremanten and John Mahama race

In the case of Alan Kyeremanten and John Mahama race, both of whom are Christians, the ethnicity impact on voters' choices were necessary to determine, how it might impact the race. Note that this is a more traditional race and not unique compared to Dr Bawumia v John Mahama. In the case of whether the ethnicity played a role in voters' preferences, 12% said it was an important factor, whilst 75% said it was not important/less important. 12% were neutral.




Figure 24 Ethnic factor in Alan Kyeremanten and John Mahama race

#### Alan Kyeremanten v John Mahama- Key Demographic Analysis

In the race between Alan v Mahama, Mahama still attracts more male and female voters than Alan with 50% and 49% respectively.




Figure 25 Alan v Mahama - Gender

With regards to party affiliation, Alan attracts 67% of NPP supporters and 14% of NDC. Mahama support amongst NPP supporters in circa 20%, an increase of 12% over the January poll.




Figure 26 Alan v Mahama - Party Affiliations

Alan support amongst the Christian groups is 42% compared to 44% for John Mahama. From the Muslim bloc Alan attracts 31% support of Muslims whilst Mahama attracts 60% support.




Figure 27 Alan v Mahama - Main Religions

#### Against Alan Kyeremanten, John Mahama still attracts support across all levels of education (see




Figure 28 Alan v Mahama - Educational Level

# Who do you trust to best manage the economy?

On the question of who voters trust to manage the economy amongst the frontrunners of the major parties, almost halve of voters, 46.8% trust John Mahama will manage the economy better compared Dr Mahamudu Bawumia and Alan. 26.5% of voters believe Dr Bawumia will be a better job whilst 15.4% believe Alan Kyeremanten will do a better job.




Figure 29 Trust to manage the Economy

#### Who do you trust to best create job opportunities?

On the question of who voters trust best to create jobs, approximately 46.6% of voters trust John Mahama to create jobs, 26.6% trust Dr Bawumia to create jobs whilst 15.3% of voters trust Alan Kyeremanten on job creations.




Figure 30 Trust to create jobs

#### Who do trust best to manage the challenges in education?

On the question of who voters trust best to manage education and its challenges, 47.7% of voters trust John Mahama to deal with the issues better compared to 25.8% who trust Dr Bawumia and 15.2% in the case of Alan Kyeremanten.




Figure 31 Trust to manage education

#### Who do you trust to best build infrastructures such as schools, roads, hospitals, etc.?

On Infrastructure, 54.9% of voters trust John Mahama to build infrastructure compared to 21.5% for Dr Bawumia and 13.8% for Alan Kyeremanten.




Figure 32 Trust to build infrastructure

#### MPs chances of retaining seats

On whether voters were likely to vote to retain their members of parliament, approximately 49% of voters indicated that they very likely/likely going to vote to re-elect their MPs nationwide. 35% are unlikely/very unlikely go to vote for their current MPs, whilst 16% are neutral.




Figure 33 Likely to vote for current MPs

# Voters intention to vote "skirt and blouse"

Voters were also asked whether they would consider voting one party in the presidential and another party for the parliamentary, only a quarter of all voters indicated in affirmative, 25%. 57% of voters said they are unlikely/very unlikely going to vote "skirt and blouse" in 2024. 18% of voters had no opinion on the question.




Figure 34 "Skirt & Blouse" voting




Figure 35 Demography- Gender




Figure 36 Demography-Age Groups




Figure 37 Demography-Education




Figure 38 Demography- Employment status




Figure 39 Demography-Religions




Figure 40 Demography-Ethnic groups




Figure 41 Demography- Party Affiliations




Figure 42 Proportion of samples allocated to regions




Figure 43 Greater Accra constituencies




Figure 44 Ashanti region constituencies




Figure 45 Central Region constituencies




Figure 46 Eastern Region constituencies




Figure 47 Upper West constituencies




Figure 48 Upper East constituencies




Figure 49 Oti constituencies




Figure 50 Volta region constituencies




Figure 51 Western Region constituencies




Figure 52 western North constituencies




Figure 53 Northern region constituencies




Figure 54 North East constituencies




Figure 55 Ahafo constituencies




Figure 56 Bono constituencies




Figure 57 Bono East constituencies




Figure 58 Savannah constituencies
