
- \square Sample size was selected using a sample calculator at 95% confidence level with a margin of error of \pm -4.045.














Sample Allocations to Electoral Areas






Direction of the country & President's Job Approval

Is the country heading in the right or wrong direction?






Direction of the country by party affiliation






Do you approve or disapprove the job performance of the President in his second term?


















Why are you not in support of the E-levy









If there is a by-election who would you vote for?








Who would you voe for in a by-election in Dome-Kwabenya?- Results by Electoral Areas






Voters choice for by-election by party affiliation






Choice of Parliamentary Candidate v Recalling Adwoa Sarfo

Proportion of voters backing candidates but want them not to vote for the E-levy if elected



If you were a delegate at the next NPP presidential primaries, which of the following candidates would you vote for?






Voters' Preference in NDC Primaries



If you were a delegate at the next NDC presidential primaries, which of the following candidates would you vote for?






If the 2024 elections were between Dr Mahamudu Bawumia and John Mahama, who would you vote for as president?








Bawumia v Mahama by Religion




Bawumia v Mahama by Ethnic Groups






Voters' Preference – General Elections Alan Kyeremanteng v John Mahama



If the 2024 elections were between Alan Kyeremanteng and John Mahama, who would you vote for as president?








Alan v Mahama by Religion




Alan v Mahama by Ethinic Groups






Who is best to replace President Akuffo Addo in 2025?
