46. Which of the following candidates did you vote for as president in the 2020 elections?



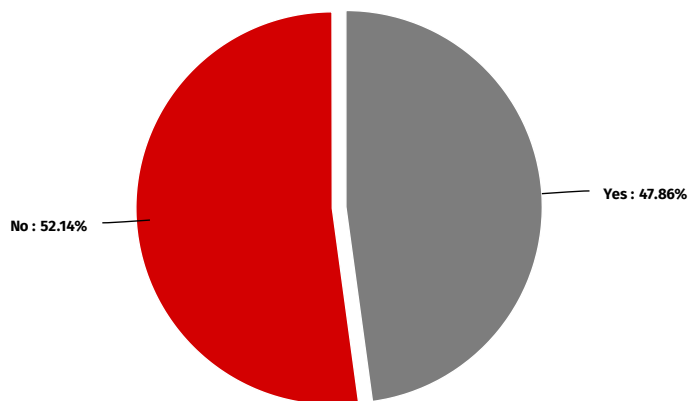
