# National Opinion Poll Presidential Speeches 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- ❑ A snap opinion poll conducted by Global InfoAnalytics after the president's speech shows that a majority of respondents want the president to step down 54% support the call for stepping down compared to 40% who oppose it, 6% did not have opinion.
- ❑ On the call for the Economic Management Team, led by the vice president to be replaced following the economic crisis, 78% of respondents support the call whilst 18% do not support it, and 4% did not have opinion.
- ❑ When respondents were asked how they received the president's speech, only 12% said it was inspiring. 25% said it was uninspiring, 22% said it addressed the major issues whilst 38% said it did not address the issues and 2% did not have an opinion.
- ❑ In the case of John Mahama's speech, only 11% said it was inspiring, 9% said it was uninspiring. 38% said it addressed the major issues whilst 11% said it did not address the issues and 6% did not have an opinion.
- ❑ On the question which of the two speeches gave them "HOPE", 16% said Nana Addo's speech gave them hope compared to 56% for John Mahama. 15% said none gave them hope and another 11% said both gave them hope whilst 3% did not have opinion.
- ❑ On who respondents trust to better manage the crisis if elected, 43% of respondents back John Mahama, 17% back Alan Kyerematen, 14% back Dr Mahamudu Bawumia, 8% back Kennedy Agyapong, 1% back Dr Kwabena Duffuor and 19% prefer someone else.

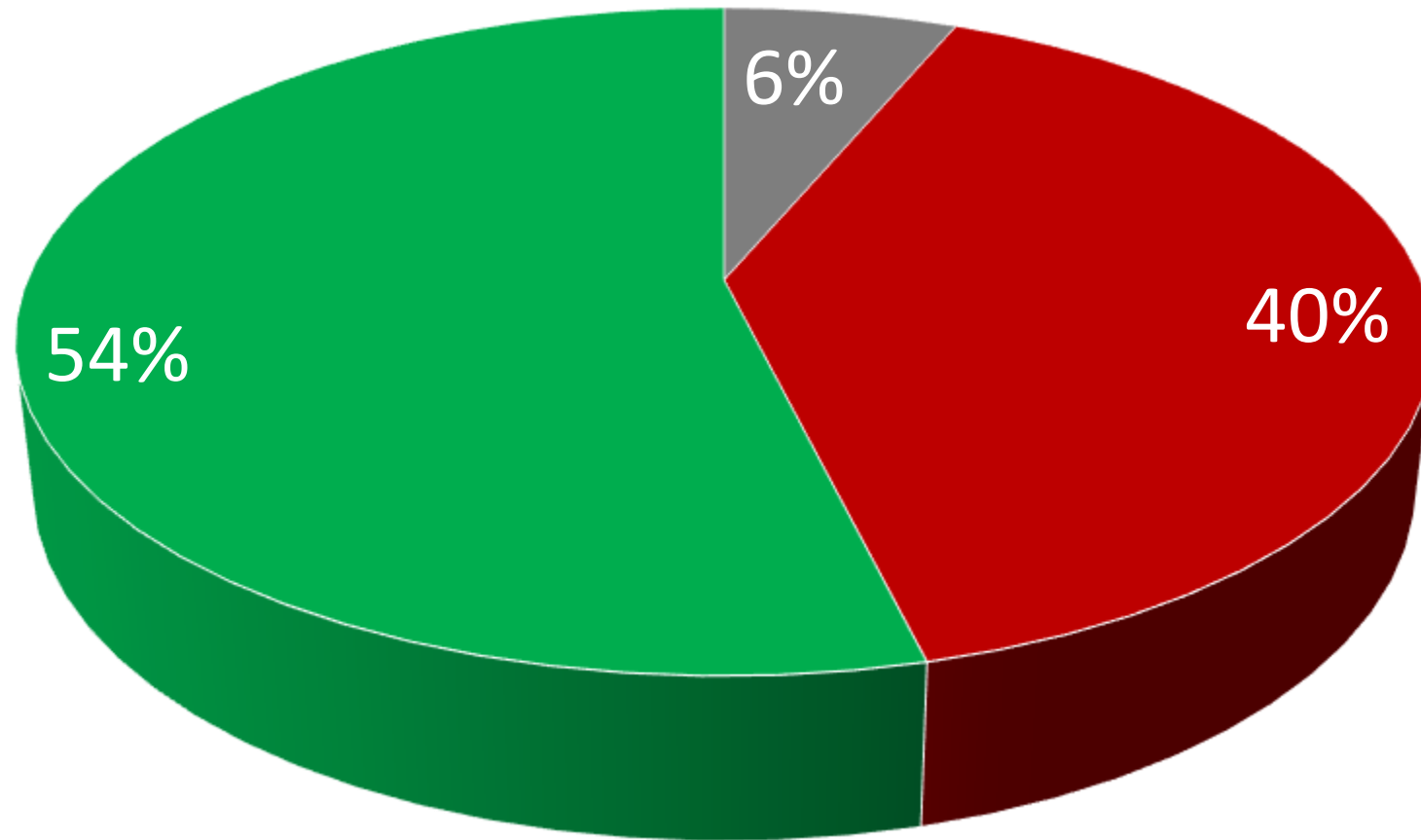

# Methodology and Approach:

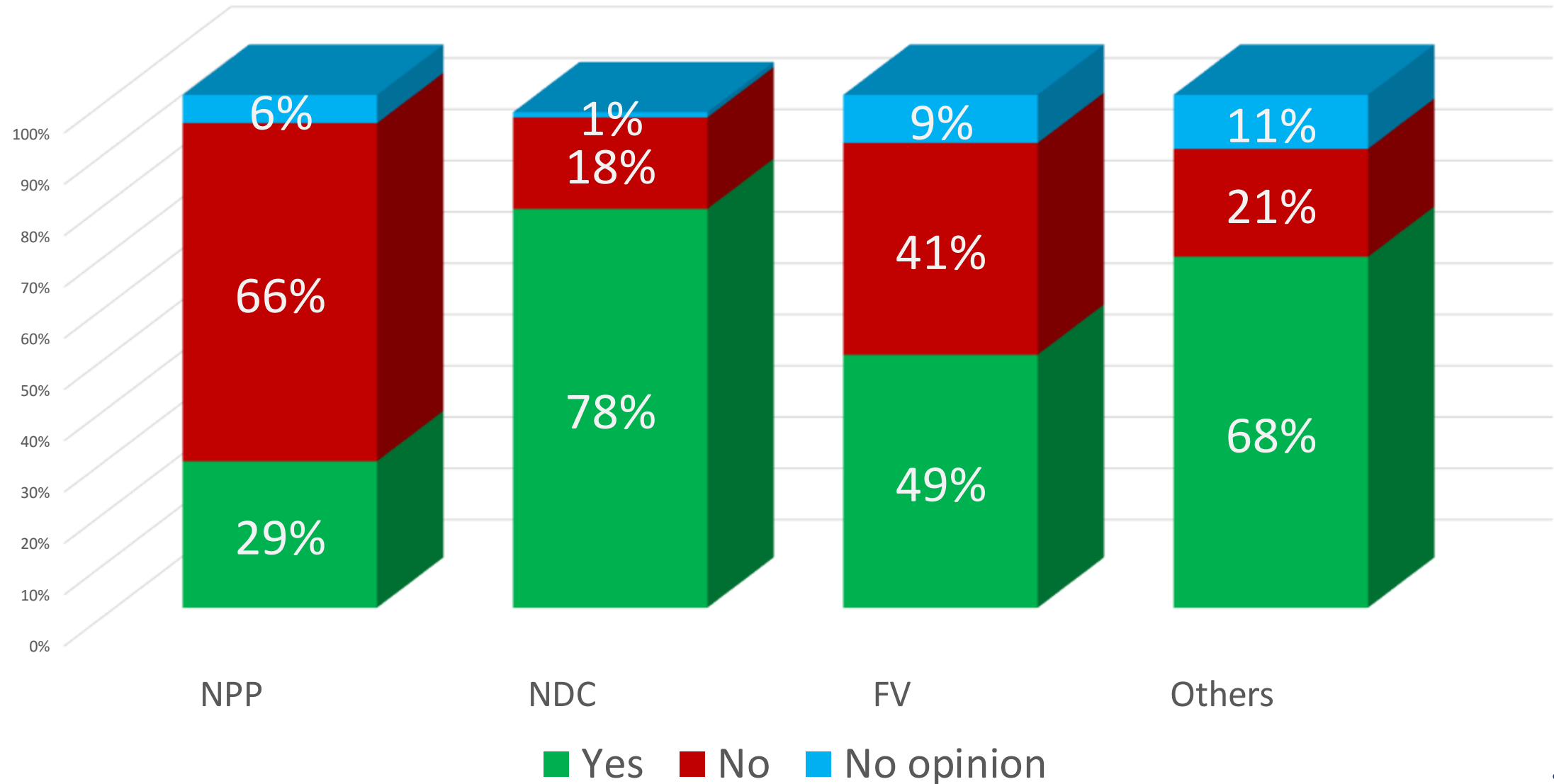
- Sample size: 1,407
- Confidence level: 99%
- MoE:  $\pm 3.434\%$
- The sample size was allocated to all 16 regions based on total number of voters in each of the regions as per the EC 2020 register with an estimated voter population of 17 million
- Voters were interviewed randomly in all the regional capitals.
- Interviews were conducted between 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022 and 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022.

# Do you support the call for the President to step down?

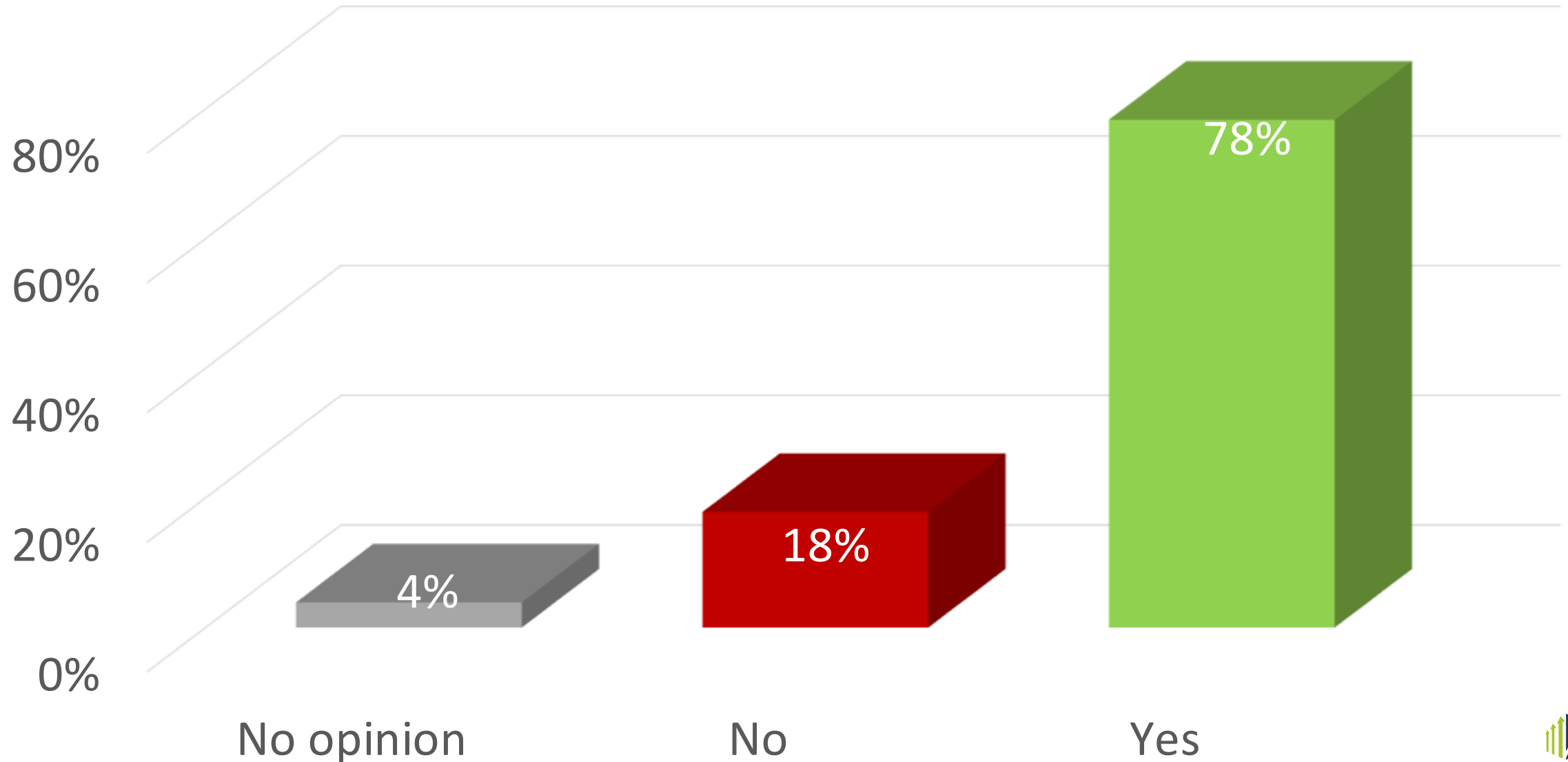

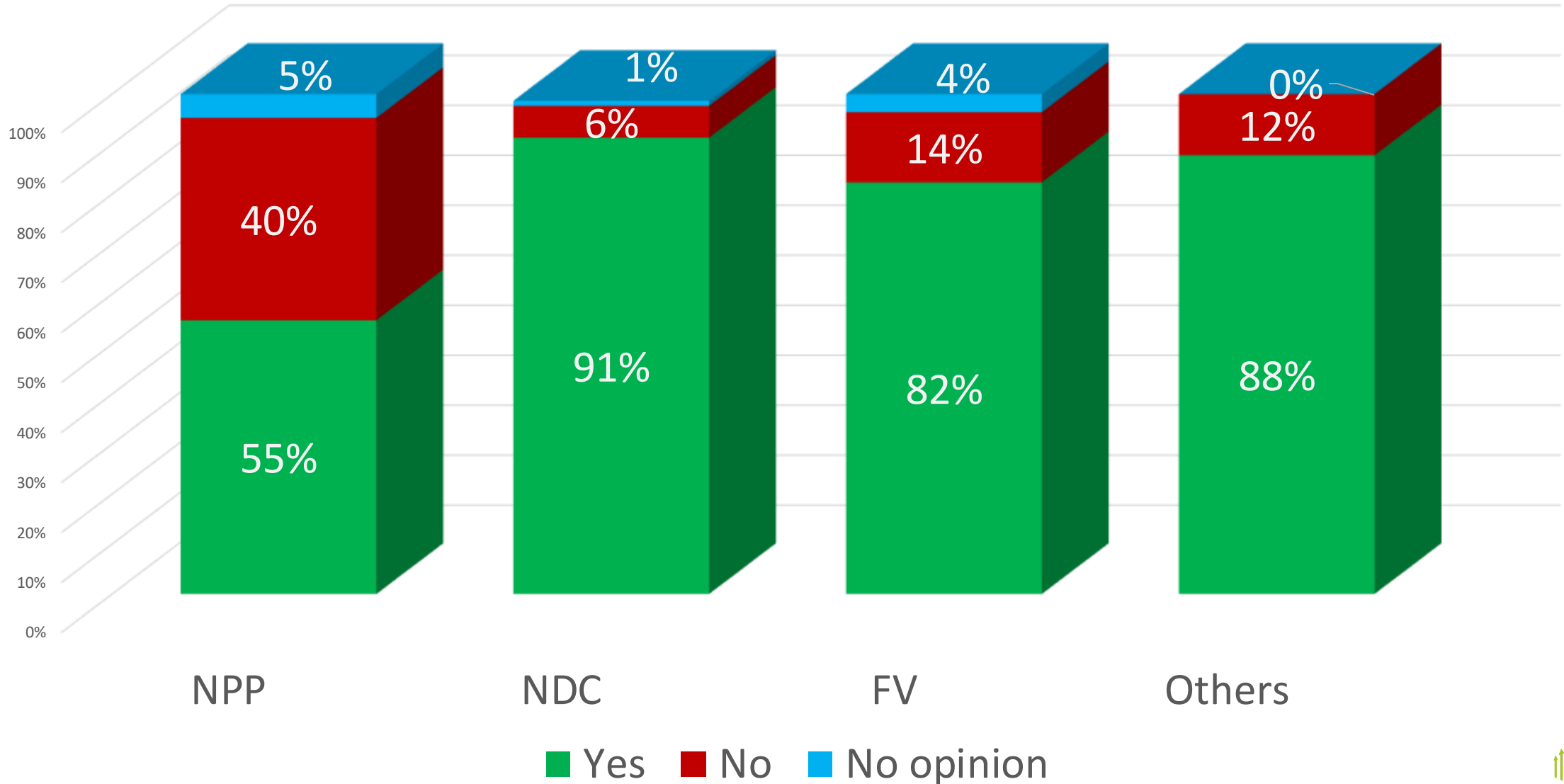
# Do you support the call for the President to step down? Party Affiliations

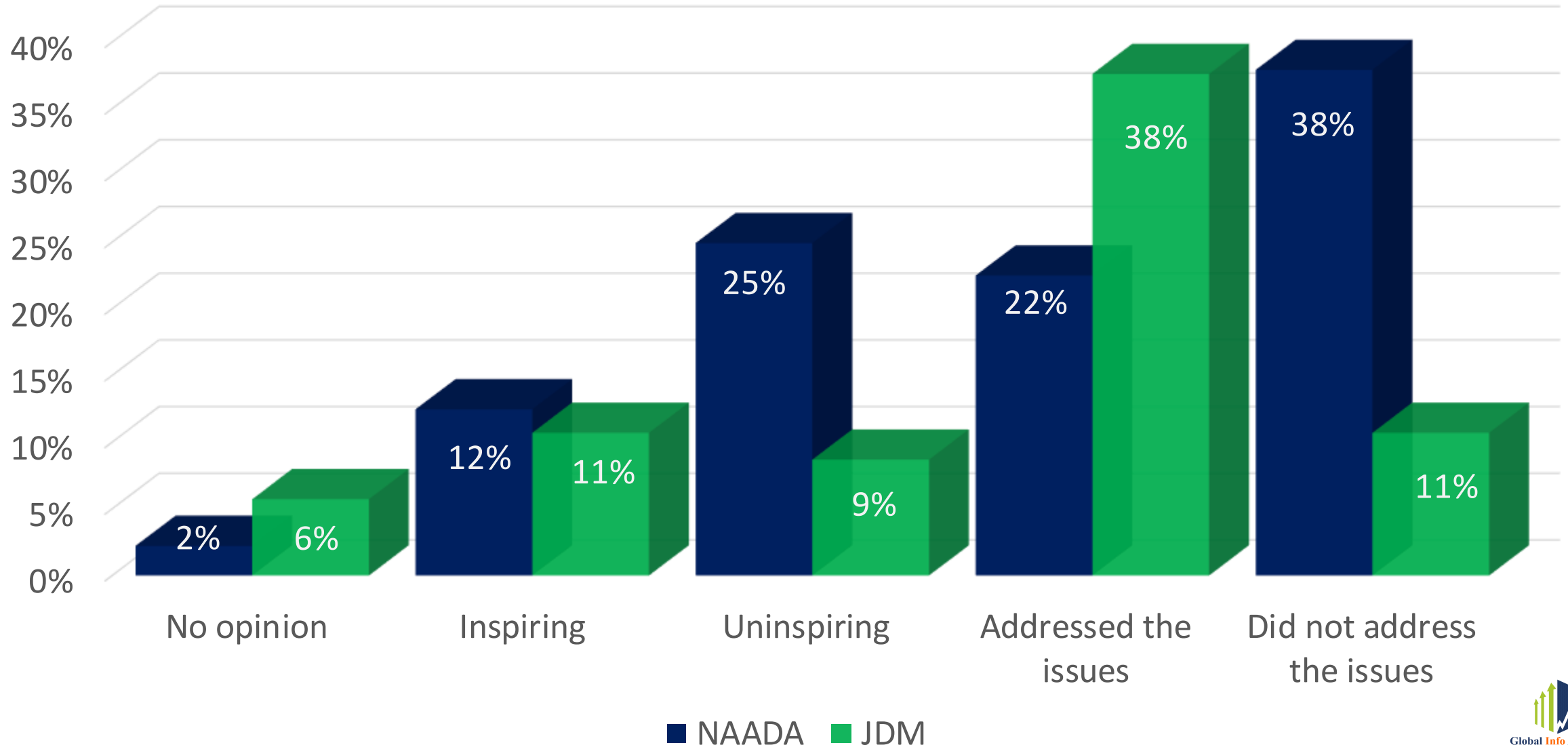


# Should the EMT led by the Vice President be Replaced?

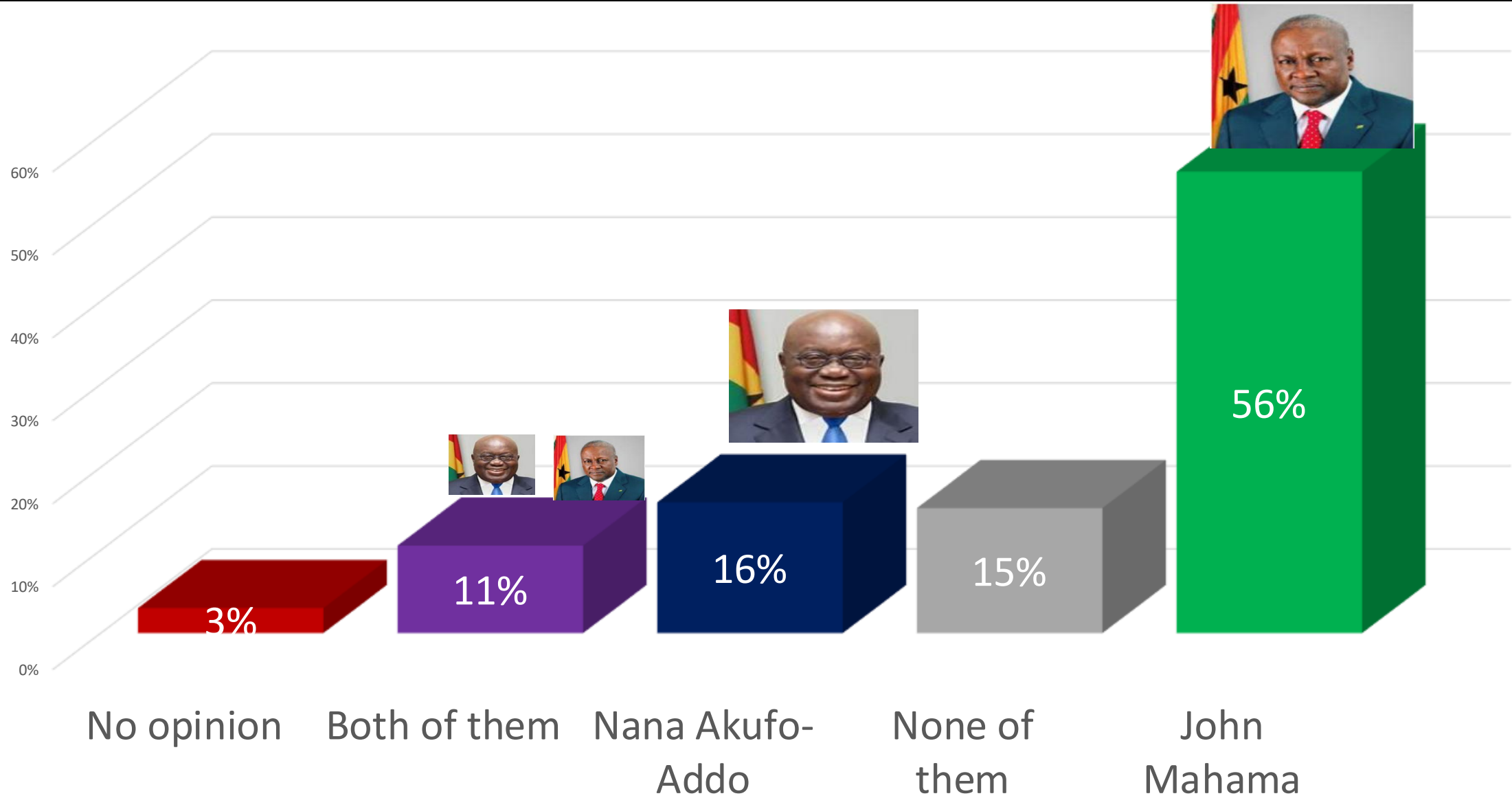




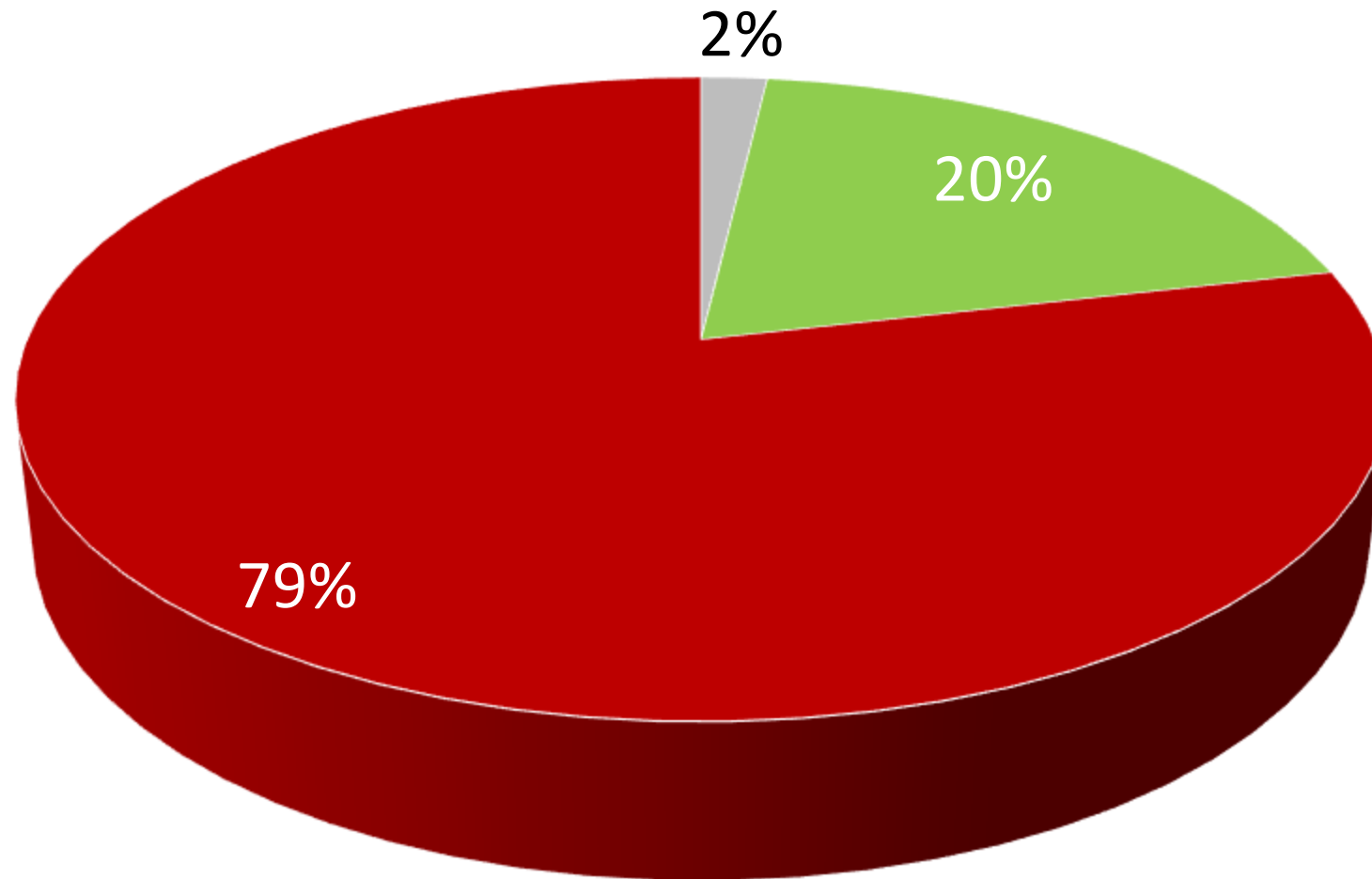

# Which of the two speeches gave you hope?



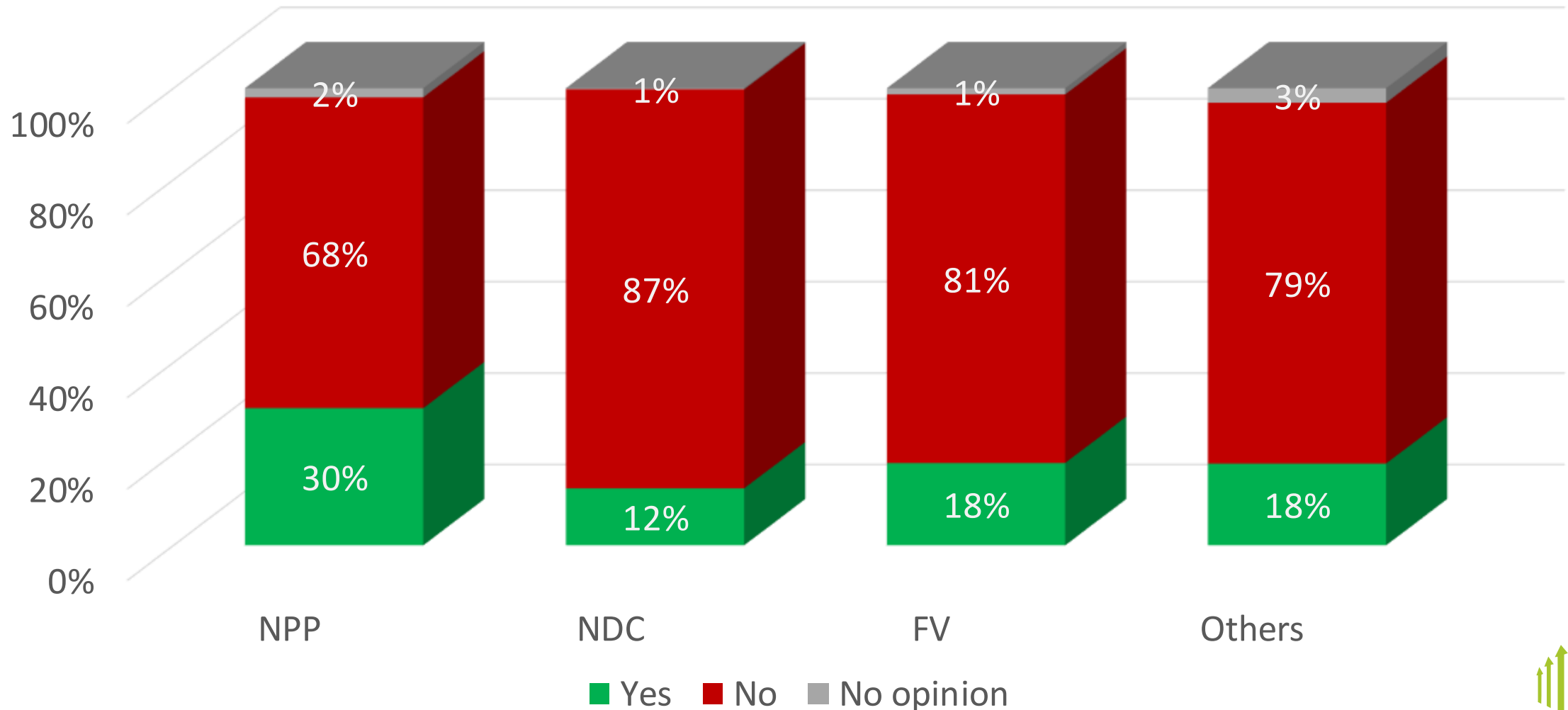
# Do you think the government is handling the crisis well?



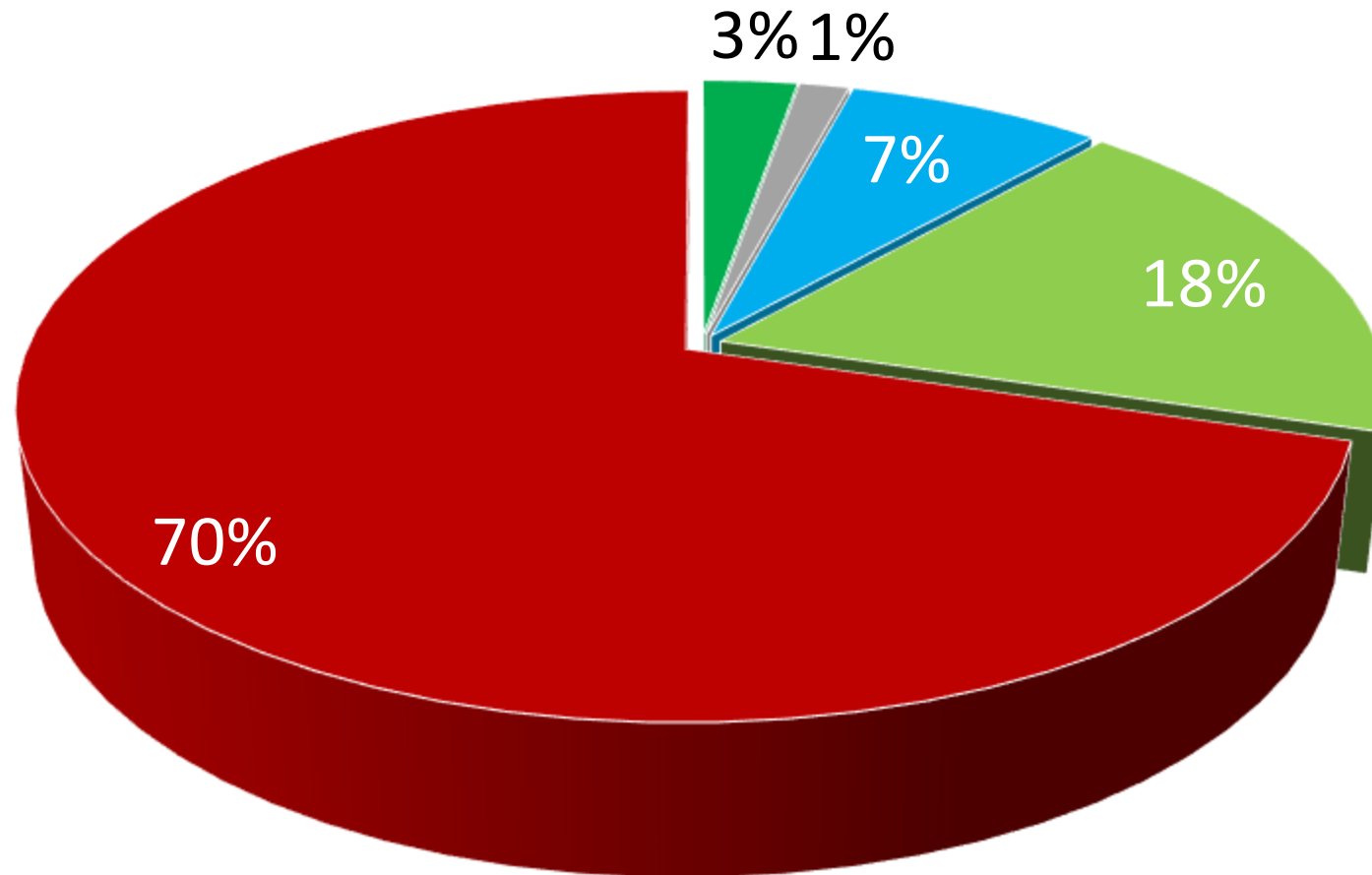

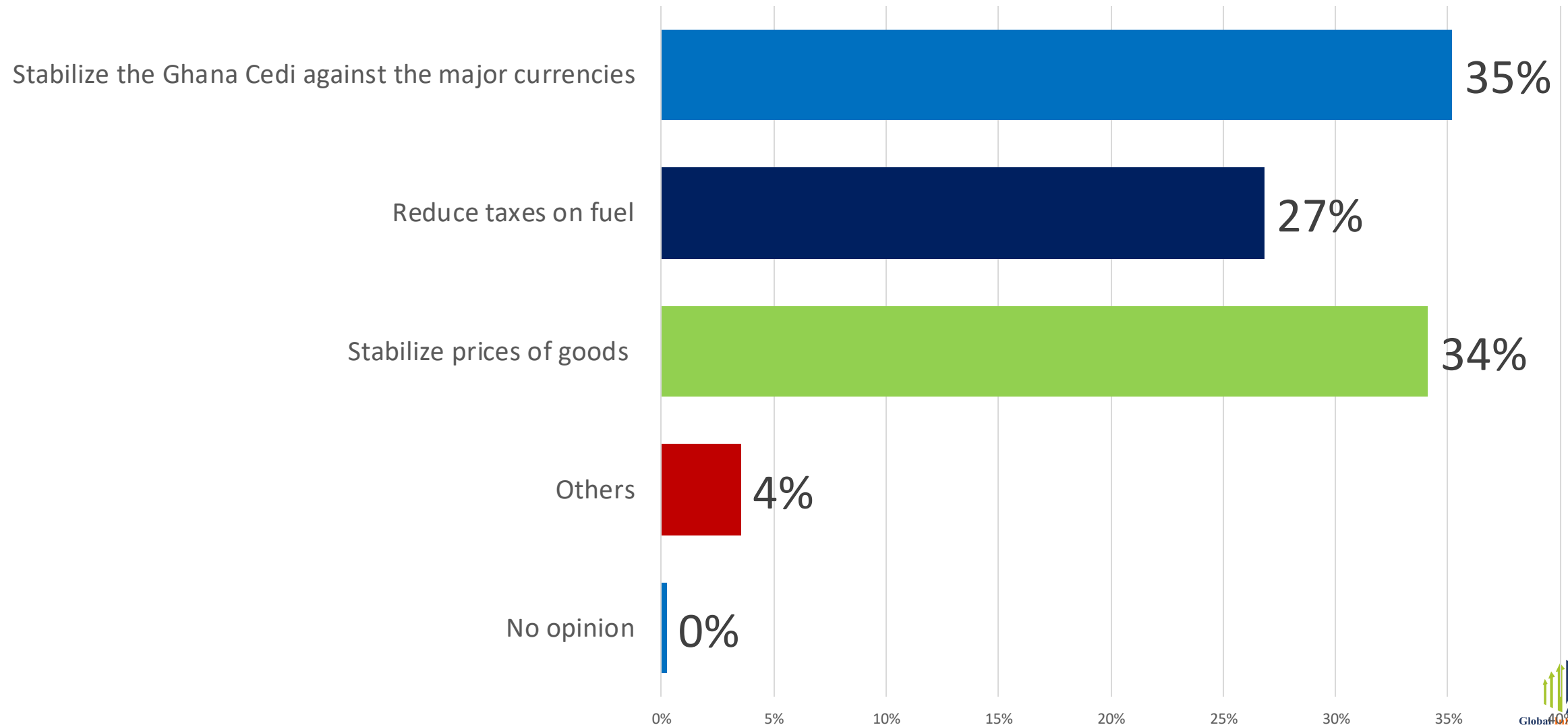


# What is your overall Assessment of How the Government is Responding to the Economic Crisis?

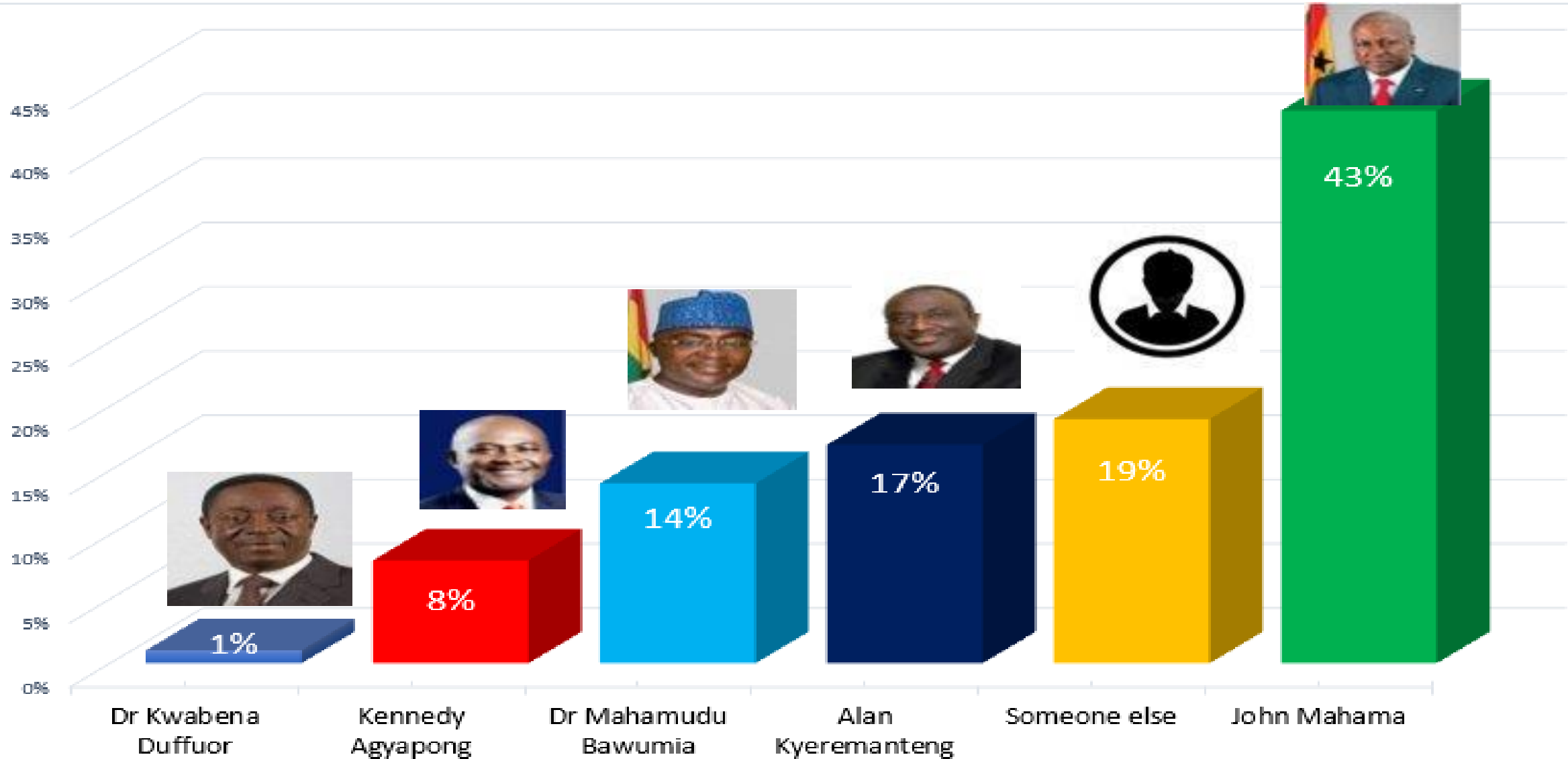

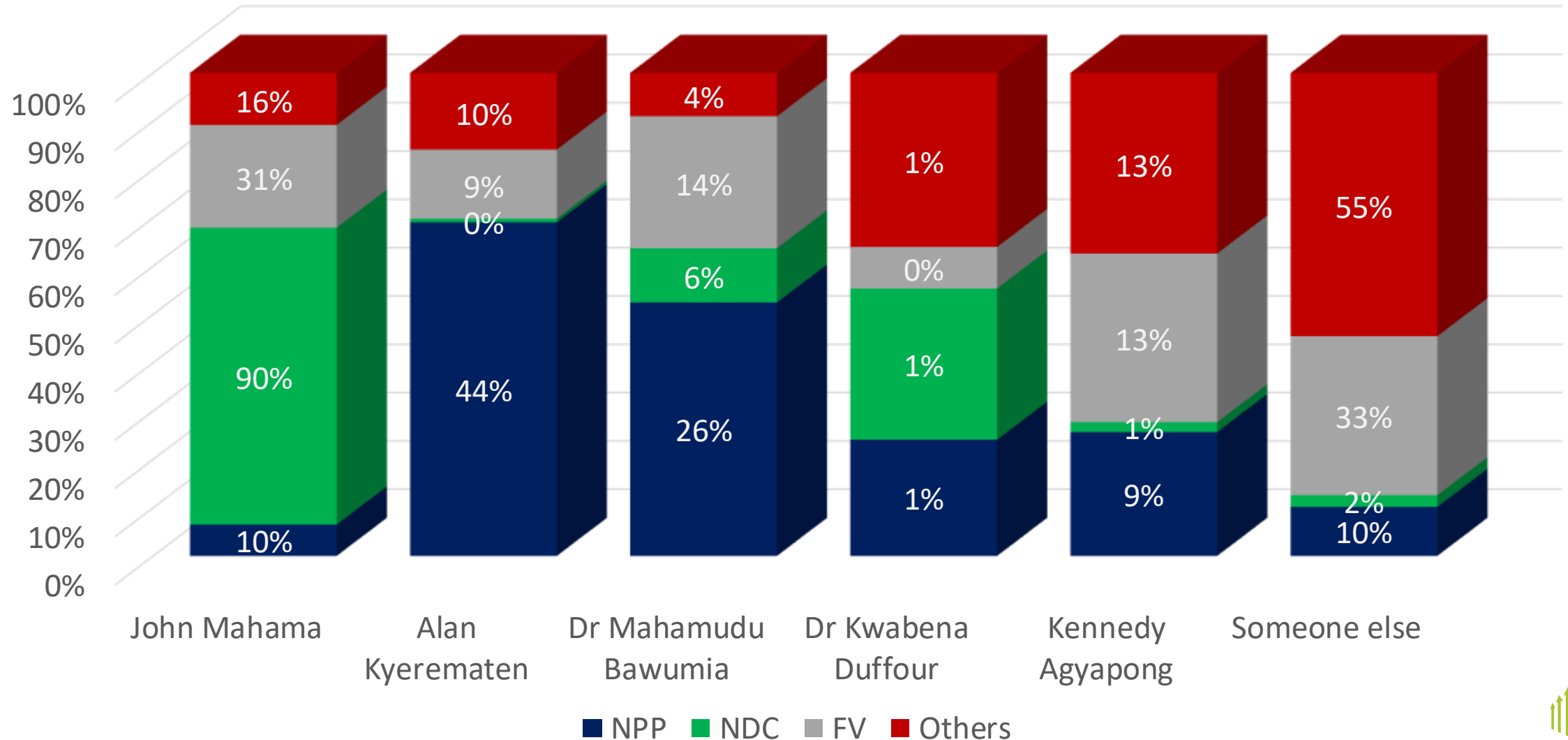
If you were to tell the government one thing that they could do to help with the crisis, which of the following would you want them to address urgently?



# Which of the following persons would you trust to better manage this crisis if elected?

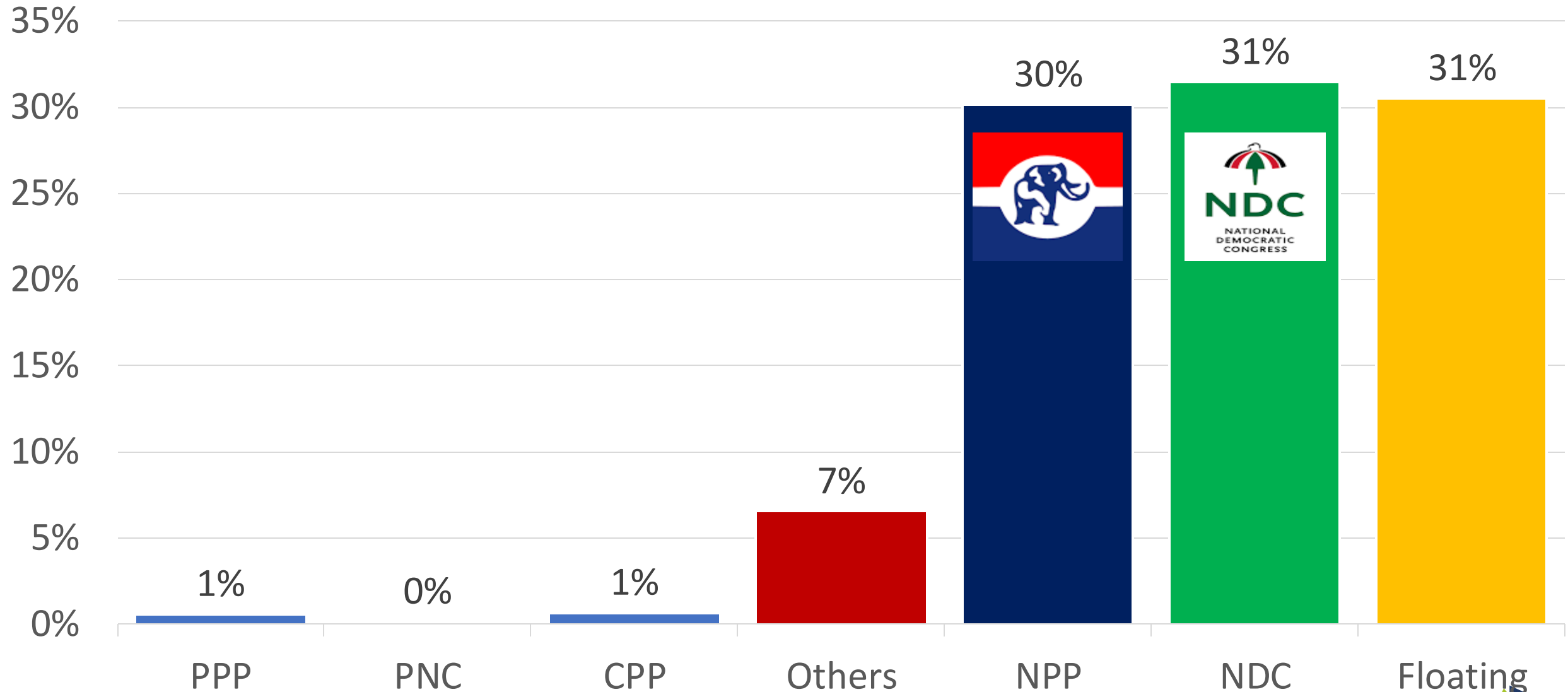


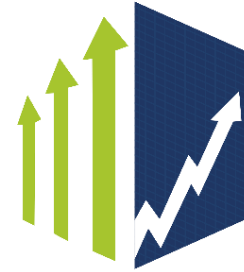
# Which of the following persons would you trust to better manage this crisis if elected? Party Affiliations
